# *Our Guest Speaker*

## *Dr Declan McKenna*



Dr Declan McKenna is a senior lecturer and cancer scientist in the School of Biomedical Sciences at Ulster University, Coleraine. Originally from Belcoo, he attended St Michael's GS from 1986 to 1993, leaving as, "one of the coolest students in the year group."

He then moved to Queen's University, Belfast, where he completed a BSc degree in Biochemistry, followed by a PhD in Molecular Biology. Since then, he has built a career in cancer research and has published many research articles in books, journals and media outlets, as well as presenting his work all over the world.

Currently, his research laboratory in Coleraine is focused on discovering new ways to improve diagnosis and therapy for prostate cancer. He has received several prizes for his work, including a recent Distinguished Research Fellowship Award for his breakthrough work in prostate cancer.

Dr McKenna is also Academic Division Head within Biomedical Sciences at Coleraine, where he teaches undergraduate and postgraduate students. He is a registered member of the STEM Ambassador programme in Northern Ireland and makes regular contributions to the annual NI Science Festival, the W5 Science Discovery Centre and other Public Engagement in Science initiatives.

Outside of work, Dr McKenna maintains a keen interest in a number of sports and gamely suffers through Fermanagh's GAA exploits each year. He is a film lover and has written about movies for RTE Brainstorm, The Guardian and his own film blog.
