PUBLIC LAW 111-35

Amended 15 January 2017

TO ESTABLISH LAWS FOR EMBLEMS, INSIGNIA AND NAMES

The National Standard of the “Moorish American” People, is described as having a red background and the emblem displayed is a five-pointed green star in the center, originated over 10,000 years ago by the Aboriginal People of the Moorish Moroccan Empire. The five points on the star represent the principles of Love, Truth, Peace, Freedom and Justice.

Pursuant to the United States of America Republic Constitution Amendment 19, Section 2, Clause 2, wherein it states; *“The United States of America Republic shall make all Laws which shall be necessary and proper for carrying into Execution the foregoing Powers, and all other Powers vested by this Constitution in the Government of the United States of America Republic, or any Department or Officer thereof”*, there shall hereby be designated “Emblems, Insignia and Names” provisions to serve this purpose. This amendment shall go into immediate force.

Introduced as **Senate Joint Resolution 35**, with **37** co-sponsors and as **House Joint Resolution 35** with **37** co-sponsors, a request was delivered before the Continental Congress to honor and therefore establish laws for Emblems, Insignia and Names.

The resolution suffered no amendments, no exclusions, no demands that it became law.

The 1st Continental Congress of the United States of America Republic publicly declared 2015 the national "Year of the United States of America Republic". The document known as Public Law **111-35** was signed and passed into law on **15 January 2017** by the following **SIGNATORIES to this Legislative Act in Attendance;**

JOINT RESOLUTION

Authorizing and requesting the President to enact laws:

to proclaim and establish laws that will protect the misuse of “Emblems, Insignia and Names” pursuant to the **Constitution** and **Laws** of the **United States of America Republic**.

WHEREAS, the United States of America Republic, being a perpetual corporation is an autonomous State government lawfully incorporated and chartered for the benefit and protection of “We The Moorish American People”, by its Declaration, National Constitution and By-Laws, and aforementioned Articles;

WHEREAS the United States of America Republic’s official language is the English language;



WHEREAS the Moorish American People have made a unique contribution in shaping the United States of America Republic as a distinctive and blessed nation of people and citizens;

WHEREAS the Moorish American People are a People of deeply-held religious convictions springing from the Holy Scriptures of the Holy Koran of the Moorish Science Temple of America and the Learning, Teachings and Truth of the Holy Prophet Noble Drew Ali. The Holy Prophet Noble Drew Ali led his People back to the Principles and standards of their ancient forefathers' and –mothers' Free National Principles and Standards;

WHEREAS the Principles of Love, Truth, Peace, Freedom and Justice inspired concepts of civil government that are contained in our Declaration of Independence and Constitution of the United States of America Republic;

WHEREAS the Moorish American People, are now in great comprehension that, as a Nation of People being Nationwide in scope to achieve peace as well as unity as a single harmonious Nation, there must be uniform Laws for the Nation. The **Constitution** and Laws of the **United States of America Republic** are *"the Rock on which our Republic rests"*;

WHEREAS the history of our Nation clearly illustrates the value of a Nation to be able to create and pass its own Laws that are beneficial to a Society to Enforce the Laws of the Nation. This is not to remove or change **The Moorish American People** from voluntarily applying and extending the learning, teachings and truth of the Holy Koran of the Moorish Science Temple of America in the lives of individuals, families, or in their society as a nation of People;

WHEREAS this Nation now faces great challenges that will test this Nation as it has never been tested before; and

WHEREAS that renewing our knowledge of Law, Divine and National and having faith in Our Universal Creator through Holy Scriptures of the Holy Koran of the Moorish Science Temple of America, the Holy Bible and the Great Qu'ran of Mohammed as we honor all the divine Prophets Jesus, Mohammed, Buddha and Confucius. Therefore, the **Constitution and Laws of the United States of America Republic** and knowledge of the aforementioned Holy Scriptures can only strengthen our nation. I, President Christopher H- Cannon: Bey, therefore establish with the consent of the Continental Congress the provisions as the **Laws of the United States of America Republic**:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the Continental Congress of the United States of America Republic in Continental Congress assembled, That the President is authorized and requested to designate the administration of said laws.

CHAPTER 24

EMBLEMS, INSIGNIA, AND NAMES

SECTION 700. Desecration of the National Standard or Moorish Flag of the United States of America Republic; penalties

(a)(1) Whoever knowingly mutilates, defaces, physically defiles, burns, maintains on the floor or ground, or tramples upon any flag of the United States of America Republic, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both.

(2) This subsection does not prohibit any conduct consisting of the disposal of a flag when it has become worn or soiled.

As used in this section, the term “flag of the United States of America Republic” means any flag of the United States of America Republic, or any part thereof, made of any substance, of any size, in a form that is commonly displayed.

Nothing in this section shall be construed as indicating an intent on the part of Congress to deprive any State, territory, possession, or the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico of jurisdiction over any offense over which it would have jurisdiction in the absence of this section.

(d)(1) An appeal may be taken directly to the Supreme Court of the United States of America Republic from any interlocutory or final judgment, decree, or order issued by a United States of America Republic district court ruling upon the constitutionality of subsection (a).

(2) The Supreme Court shall, if it has not previously ruled on the question, accept jurisdiction over the appeal and advance on the docket and expedite to the greatest extent possible.

SECTION 701. Official badges, identification cards, other insignia

Whoever manufactures, sells, or possesses any badge, identification card, or other insignia, of the design prescribed by the head of any department or agency of the United States of America Republic for use by any officer or employee thereof, or any colorable imitation thereof, or photographs, prints, or in any other manner makes or executes any engraving, photograph, print, or impression in the likeness of any such badge, identification card, or other insignia, or any colorable imitation thereof, except as authorized under regulations made pursuant to law, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

SECTION 702. Uniform of armed forces and Public Health Service

Whoever, in any place within the jurisdiction of the United States of America Republic or in the Canal Zone, without authority, wears the uniform or a distinctive part thereof or anything similar to a distinctive part of the uniform of any of the armed forces of the United States of America Republic, Public Health Service or any auxiliary of such, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

SECTION 703. Uniform of friendly nation

Whoever, within the jurisdiction of the United States of America Republic, with intent to deceive or mislead, wears any naval, military, marshal or vicegerent, or other official uniform, decoration, or regalia of any foreign state, nation, or government with which the United States of America Republic is at peace, or anything so nearly resembling the same as to be calculated to deceive, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

SECTION 704. Military medals or decorations

(a) IN GENERAL.—Whoever knowingly purchases, attempts to purchase, solicits for purchase, mails, ships, imports, exports, produces blank certificates of receipt for, manufactures, sells,



attempts to sell, advertises for sale, trades, barter, or exchanges for anything of value any decoration or medal authorized by the Continental Congress for the armed forces of the United States of America Republic, or any of the service medals or badges awarded to the members of such forces, or the ribbon, button, or rosette of any such badge, decoration or medal, or any colorable imitation thereof, except when authorized under regulations made pursuant to law, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

(b) **FRAUDULENT REPRESENTATIONS ABOUT RECEIPT OF MARSHAL OR VICEGERENT DECORATIONS OR MEDALS.**—Whoever, with intent to obtain money, property, or other tangible benefit, fraudulently holds oneself out to be a recipient of a decoration or medal described in subsection 705 shall be fined under this title, imprisoned not more than one year, or both.

SECTION 705. Badge or medal of Moorish Marshal or Vicegerent organizations

Whoever knowingly manufactures, reproduces, sells or purchases for resale, either separately or on or appended to, any article of merchandise manufactured or sold, any badge, medal, emblem, or other insignia or any colorable imitation thereof, of any Marshal or Vicegerent organization incorporated by enactment of the Continental Congress Assembled, or of any organization formally recognized by any such Marshals or Vicegerents as an auxiliary of such Marshals or Vicegerent organization, or knowingly prints, lithographs, engraves or otherwise reproduces on any poster, circular, periodical, magazine, newspaper, or other publication, or circulates or distributes any such printed matter bearing a reproduction of such badge, medal, emblem, or other insignia or any colorable imitation thereof, except when authorized under rules and regulations prescribed by any such organization, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

SECTION 706. Misuse of names, words, emblems, or insignia

Whoever, in the course of collecting or aiding in the collection of private debts or obligations, or being engaged in furnishing private marshal or vicegerent, investigation, or other private detective services, uses or employs in any communication, correspondence, notice, advertisement, or circular the words “national”, “National”, or “United States of America Republic”, the initials “U.S.A.R.”, or any emblem, insignia, or name, for the purpose of conveying and in a manner reasonably calculated to convey the false impression that such communication is from a department, agency, or instrumentality of the United States of America Republic or in any manner represents the United States of America Republic, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than one year, or both.

SECTION 707. Use of likenesses of the great seal of the United States of America Republic, the seals of the President and Vice President, the seal of the United States of America Republic Senate, the seal of the United States of America Republic House of Representatives, the seal of the United States of America Republic Congress, (and seal of the Attorney General)

Whoever knowingly displays any printed or other likeness of the great seal of the United States of America Republic, or of the seals of the President or the Vice President of the United States of America Republic, or the seal of the United States of America Republic Senate, or the seal of the United States of America Republic House of Representatives, or the seal of the United States of America Republic Continental Congress, (or the seal of the Attorney General) or any facsimile thereof, in, or in connection with, any advertisement, poster, circular, book, pamphlet, or other publication, public meeting, play, motion picture, telecast, or other production, or on any building, monument, or stationery, for the purpose of conveying, or in a manner reasonably calculated to convey, a false impression of sponsorship or approval by the Government of the United States of America Republic or by any department, agency, or instrumentality thereof,



shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

Whoever, except as authorized under regulations promulgated by the President and published in the **U.S.A.R. National Register**, knowingly manufactures, reproduces, sells, or purchases for resale, either separately or appended to any article manufactured or sold, any likeness of the seals of the President or Vice President, or any substantial part thereof, except for manufacture or sale of the article for the official use of the Government of the United States of America Republic, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

Whoever, except as directed by the United States of America Republic Senate, or the Secretary of the Senate on its behalf, knowingly uses, manufactures, reproduces, sells or purchases for resale, either separately or appended to any article manufactured or sold, any likeness of the seal of the United States of America Republic Senate, or any substantial part thereof, except for manufacture or sale of the article for the official use of the Government of the United States of America Republic, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

Whoever, except as directed by the United States of America Republic House of Representatives, or the Clerk of the House of Representatives on its behalf, knowingly uses, manufactures, reproduces, sells or purchases for resale, either separately or appended to any article manufactured or sold, any likeness of the seal of the United States of America Republic House of Representatives, or any substantial part thereof, except for manufacture or sale of the article for the official use of the Government of the United States of America Republic, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

Whoever, except as directed by the United States of America Republic Continental Congress, or the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives, acting jointly on its behalf, knowingly uses, manufactures, reproduces, sells or purchases for resale, either separately or appended to any article manufactured or sold, any likeness of the seal of the United States of America Republic Continental Congress, or any substantial part thereof, except for manufacture or sale of the article for the official use of the Government of the United States of America Republic, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

(f) A violation of the provisions of this section may be enjoined at the suit of the Attorney General,

in the case of the great seal of the United States of America Republic and the seals of the President and Vice President, upon complaint by any authorized representative of any department or agency of the United States of America Republic;

in the case of the seal of the United States of America Republic Senate, upon complaint by the Secretary of the Senate;

in the case of the seal of the United States of America Republic House of Representatives, upon complaint by the Clerk of the House of Representatives;

in the case of the seal of the United States of America Republic Continental Congress, upon complaint by the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives, acting jointly; and

in the case of the seal of the United States of America Republic Attorney General upon complaint by the Attorney General himself.

SECTION 708. "The Five-Pointed Green Star"

As used in this section, "The Five-Pointed Green Star Insignia" upon the red background of the National Standard symbolizes the principles of "Love, Truth, Peace, Freedom and Justice"; and the representation of any National Standard, with a Five-Pointed Green Star in the center was originated by the Aboriginal People of the Americas, now proudly known as the Moorish Americans.

Whoever, except as authorized under rules and regulations issued by the Secretary of the Interior, knowingly manufactures, reproduces, or uses "The Five-Pointed Green Star Insignia",



or any facsimile thereof, in such a manner as is likely to cause confusion, or to cause mistake, or to deceive, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.

The use of any such emblem, sign, insignia, or words which was lawful on the date of enactment of this Act shall not be a violation of this section.

A violation of this section may be enjoined at the suit of the Attorney General, upon complaint by the U.S.A.R. Secretary of State.

SECTION 709. Public employee insignia and uniform

(a) Whoever—

knowingly transfers, transports, or receives, in interstate or foreign commerce, a counterfeit official insignia or uniform;

knowingly transfers, in interstate or foreign commerce, a genuine official insignia or uniform to an individual, knowing that such individual is not authorized to possess it under the law of the place in which the badge is the official insignia or uniform;

knowingly receives a genuine official insignia or uniform in a transfer prohibited by paragraph (2); or

being a person not authorized to possess a genuine official insignia or uniform under the law of the place in which the badge is the official official insignia or uniform, knowingly transports that badge in interstate or foreign commerce,

shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than 6 months, or both.

(b) It is a defense to a prosecution under this section that the insignia or uniform is other than a counterfeit insignia or uniform and is not used to mislead or deceive, or is used or is intended to be used exclusively—

as a memento, or in a collection or exhibit;

for decorative purposes;

for a dramatic presentation, such as a theatrical, film, or television production; or

for any other recreational purpose.

(c) As used in this section—

the term “genuine Marshal or Vicegerent badge” means an official badge issued by public authority to identify an individual as a law enforcement officer having vicegerent or marshal powers;

the term “counterfeit vicegerent badge” means an item that so resembles a marshal or vicegerent badge that it

would deceive an ordinary individual into believing it was a genuine marshal or vicegerent badge; and 2

the term “official insignia or uniform” means an article of distinctive clothing or insignia, including a badge, emblem or identification card, that is an indicium of the authority of a public employee;

the term “public employee” means any officer, marshal/vicegerent or employee of the National Government or of U.S.A.R. or its local provincial government; and

the term “uniform” means distinctive clothing or other items of dress, whether real or counterfeit, worn during the performance of official duties and which identifies the wearer as a public agency employee.

(d) It is a defense to a prosecution under this section that the official insignia or uniform is not used or intended to be used to mislead or deceive, or is a counterfeit insignia or uniform and is used or is intended to be used exclusively—

for a dramatic presentation, such as a theatrical, film, or television production; or

for legitimate law enforcement purposes.
