to a good end.

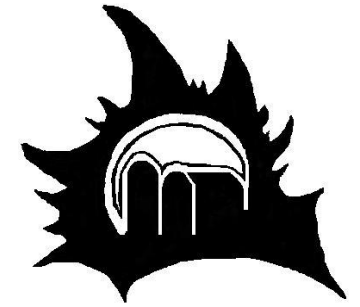

What is a CSA?

- Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a system in which consumers receive food directly from the farmers who produce it.

Is it cost effective? **YES!**

- CSA members receive their produce at prices that are less expensive than stores.

Does owning a share help my community? **YES!**

- Producing and purchasing food locally results in money remaining in the local economy.

Are CSA's beneficial to the environment? **YES!**

- Our CSA partners' food is produced using *sustainable* methods.
- Our CSA partners' products are produced using a diverse cropping system which relies on crop rotations and other natural methods to break weed and pest cycles.
- It reduces the cost of transportation.

Can I visit the farm? **YES!**

Here's what we have to offer

Produce Shares

The primary produce share is based on what vegetables and fruits is ready each week. You will receive one box per share per week. A "**double**" share, is just that! Each week you will get two boxes of produce.

- Primary share feeds 2-3 people
- Double share feeds a family

A list of the expected crops can be found on the reverse side.

We only use **NON-GMO** seeds.

Some of our seeds come from Seed Savors Exchange.

Add-ons can be made at additional costs.
