Classes offered each day: Instinct Test as the first class Saturday/Sunday followed by Novice and Open in Ring 1. Senior and Master will run in Ring 2. The second trial of the day (which will not include Instinct but will include Crazy 8s) will begin after 11:00 AM.

Entries limited to 120 runs or approx. 8 hours judging time, per judge, per day

Trial to Trial move ups are allowed ... please handle before the end of the day's trial.
Classes may be split between judges for load balancing.

After Closing (Add \$5): Instinct \$20 – Novice/Open/Crazy 8 \$25 – Senior/Master \$30

No Day of Show entries accepted. Late entries accepted on site from Tuesday March 26th until Friday March 29th until 5pm, if limits are not reached with pre-entries.

General briefing 8:00 am, Judges briefing at 8:15 am, first dog in the ring at 8:30 am
The specific running order of classes will be in your final email confirmation based on class entries received and determined by the Judges and the Trial Committee.

Entries open January 1, 2019 and close March 20, 2019.

Entries will be accepted in the order received.

Please be sure your entry is complete, signed and includes payment.

Pre-Entries must be post marked or received by March 20, 2019.

Maximum of 10 dog entries per envelope.

This Barn Hunt Event will share the grounds with North American Diving Dogs (NADD) and AKC Conformation. We hope you will want to enter all the shows, but please note that your dog must be dry before entering the Barn Hunt ring

CONFLICTS

We would like to accommodate each and every conflict but that will more than likely be impossible and you may have to make a choice. The running order for classes will be posted at each ring, each day. If you have a conflict, please ask the blind steward to put a "C" by your name. If you are not in at the ring when your blind is called, we will fill your space with someone that is present. When you are available to run, please check in and we will assign you to a new blind. We cannot guarantee you will run immediately upon checking in.

If you know you will have a conflict prior to the event, please contact the Trial Secretary to declare the conflict so she can work with you to try to resolve it.

We cannot hold a class. If you are not present by the time the class ends, you will not be able to run your dog in that class for that trial. There are two trials each day but a missed run in trial one cannot be run in trial two.

We will verify all conflicts with the judging program of other events.

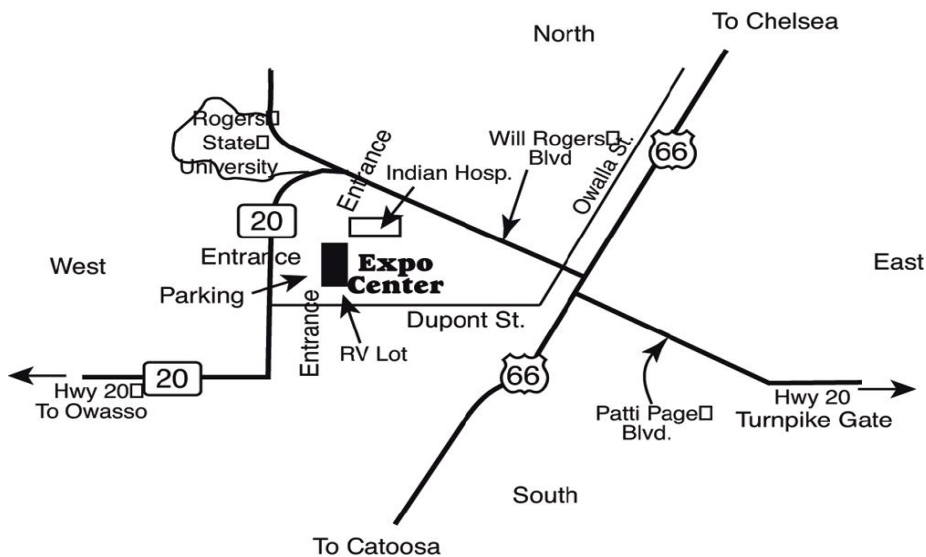

RV PARKING

Reservations for RV Parking will be available online at www.visitclaremore.org. If none available see Overflow Parking Reservation Information and Form. Parking in the parking lot with RV's will be under the direction of the Cluster. See page 7 for Parking Form to be returned to the Parking Chair. We hope that by reserving your space, it will cause less stress for those arriving and camping in the parking lot. A dump station is available for RV's arriving with full tanks that need dumped prior to parking in the Overflow Parking lot. Parents will be held responsible for children's actions in the campground & show facility. The club asks RVs arriving after midnight to respect other campers & address any problems or questions that arise after 6:00 am. A Camp Host is on site for questions or problems. Restrooms and showers are available in center of RV Campground. All campers will have access to restrooms, showers & dump station, including those on the parking lot.

No bathing of dogs in Campground Showers!

General Information and Policies

It is the responsibility of each competitor to read and understand the current Barn Hunt Association, LLC (BHA) Rules prior to participating in this event. https://www.barnhunt.com/rules/barnhuntrules_2016_final.pdf

Possessing or training with personal tubes and/or live rats is NOT permitted on the event grounds at any time.

Barn Hunt Grounds: These trials are a part of the AKC Dog Iron Cluster and other associated events. Barn Hunt rules apply to any activities held on the Barn Hunt side of the Covered Arena. The grounds, including parking, that surround the Expo Center will be subject to both BHA and AKC rules depending on which events a competitor is entered. There will be a potty area that is designated for BHA/AKC/NADD competitors and they must pick up after their dogs on the trial grounds and at the hotel. Parking to the West of the Expo Center allows easiest access to the covered arena and the show facilities.

SHOW FACILITY: Expo Building floor is concrete (Exhibition Hall). Arena building (Grooming) is packed dirt.

NO UNLOADING OR PARKING IN CIRCLE DRIVE IN FRONT OF MAIN ENTRANCE. Unloading is available on east side of arena (backside of Expo Center) through two overhead doors; one for Reserved Grooming and the other for Free Grooming. Exercise dogs in designated grassy areas. Do Not exercise dogs in front of Expo Entrance. No grooming or crating in Expo Building. Crating & Grooming in Arena Building connected to Expo building.

NO ELECTRIC CORDS OR EXERCISE PENS ALLOWED IN FREE GROOMING AREA IN THE ARENA (THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED). Private Exercise Pens are allowed in the RESERVED GROOMING AREA & designated area outside in the NORTH covered arena and outside of the WEST side of grooming arena on concrete; on concrete, plastic is required under the pens and will be placed no closer than 3 feet from exit doors and no more than 6 feet from the building wall. Exercise pens in the reserved grooming are required to have plastic sheeting covering dirt.

No dollies allowed to enter through main spectator entrance in front of Expo Building. Dogs will be allowed to enter through main entrance. No Baby Strollers. This is a smoke-free facility, this will be enforced by the Claremore Fire

Department; violators will be fined. No outside alcoholic beverages allowed. No dogs allowed in shower area. No bathing dogs in sinks in restrooms.

A bathing area is available outside of arena on north end. Wash tubs will be furnished by the club. The Dog Iron Cluster Shows are self-cleaning, meaning that all exhibitors are **required to clean** up after their own dogs. The requirement includes all rings, aisle, walkways, parking lots and all areas of the RV parking areas. Thank you for your cooperation.

Leashes and collars: See BHA Rulebook page 20 for specific information on what is allowed. Dogs cannot be brought to the ring on flexi-leads or prong collars.

Dog aggression: Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or person may be dismissed from the event if justification is found by the judge and/or Event Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded.

Bitches in season: Are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will run at the end of their class. They must wear pants at all times (including on course) while not being pottied. They must be pottied in a designated area away from the other dogs. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until the closing date of March 20, 2019, if you wish to withdraw. **The trial secretary must be notified prior to or upon arrival. Failure to do so may result in a disqualification and dismissal from the event.**

Videotaping and photography: Is allowed and encouraged! Videotaping by individuals for their own personal use will be allowed outside show rings only. The show committee reserves the right to regulate placement of cameras to prevent interference with traffic flow and exhibiting of dogs.

Volunteers: Are appreciated and needed!

Spectators: Spectators are welcome but must adhere to the Code of Good Sportsmanship outlined in the BHA Official Rulebook.

Sportsmanship: All competitors/handlers and spectators are expected to follow the rules of the BHA and demonstrate good sportsmanship. Please do not discuss hide placement or any details of a dog's performance that may provide information or clues to other handlers or may be overheard. Please be cognizant of teams competing in the ring and avoid loud or disruptive distractions.

Crating: Dogs must be leashed or crated when not actively working, and never tied out/left attached to anything other than a human. Crating space available inside, on grounds or in vehicles. Dogs being left by agents or owners in grooming building overnight are requested to identify the dog's crate with an emergency phone number or information in case of an emergency.

Awards: Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in the classes, including Instinct. Flat ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in Novice, Open, Senior, and Masters classes in each height division. High in Class rosettes will be awarded to fastest qualifying run in each class, excluding Instinct.

Payment and entry information: Entries will NOT be accepted without signatures and payment. Entries are invalid without a signed Release Agreement Form. Owners are responsible for entry errors. Please write clearly and proof your entry. BHA will not make corrections once results are submitted. Incomplete forms and returned checks are invalid entries. There is a \$35.00 fee for all returned checks. Entries accepted on a first come/first served basis.

Refunds are ONLY allowed if requested before the closing date of November 18, 2018

No event fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

BHA registration number IS required! You can register your dog on line at <http://www.barnhunt.com>. BHA registration fee is \$30, and **is a lifetime fee for that dog**. There are no annual fees with BHA, and no membership fees for dog owners.

Certification of Agreement upon Registration or Entry of Dog
