Longhorn IP Subsidiary Initiates Patent Infringement Action Against HTC in Nanjing, China

Longhorn IP today announced that its subsidiary Ox Mobile Technologies LLC (OMT) has filed legal proceedings for patent infringement against HTC Corporation and HTC Communication Co. Ltd. and distributors of HTC products in the Nanjing Court on October 18, 2017. OMT is asserting that one of its Chinese patents are infringed by the manufacturing and sales of HTC products implementing LTE cellular communications standard.

This follows patent infringement cases against HTC in the Beijing IP Court by L2 Mobile Technologies LLC (L2MT), another Longhorn IP subsidiary, in September of this year. Both OMT and L2MT are represented by Beijing East IP, a leading intellectual property firm in China, founded by Dr. Gao Lulin, the founding Commissioner of the State Intellectual Property Office (SIPO).
