- Removal or chipping of branches.
- Usable wood left in appropriate lengths for handling for landowners use.
- Foreman's discretion. Wood not removed from right-of-way within 30 days may be removed at Road
- 4 Stump removal is at discretion of Road Foreman

Board. Tree plantings in Town's right-of-way are at owner's risk unless approved by Select
