- Copies of NRHA member confirmation for owners and riders plus a copy of the horse licence and a copy of the receipt of payment MUST be received with the entry form, please. Failure to supply this information at the time of entry will incur an additional Office fee charge.**
- LATE ENTRIES:** *Late entries will be accepted. Late fees apply (Total Class Cost + \$15) per class. A late entry box and late entry forms will be placed outside the office to receive your nominations. The late entry form must be completed correctly with payment and be placed in the late entry box NLT 7.00 PM the evening prior to the commencement of the class. Any incorrect or incomplete entry will not be accepted.*

- SQRHA's facility at LIEC will be available from **Friday 5th April 2019**.
- Show fees may be paid via cheque or Internet transfer into the SQRHA bank account. Please see below for banking details. Please provide a copy of the internet banking transfer receipt when emailing your nominations to the show secretary.

- No lunging of any horse will be permitted in either the outside or the inside warm up pen in the hour prior to the start of the show or whilst the show is in progress.
- No smoking in the grandstand or within 5 metres of the catering van.
- No alcohol is to be consumed in the actual arena or the warm up pen
- No glass is permitted in the arena or warm up pen.
- Only current members of NRHA & Reining Australia (R.A) & SQRHA or an Affiliate Club are permitted to ride a horse on the showgrounds. For insurance purposes, anyone riding astride a horse must be covered by membership even if not competing. An employee must submit a Certificate of Currency of Insurance that covers any employee riding but not competing.
- A vet certificate or medical certificate must be provided, before any requests for refunds will be considered.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they have checked their current eligibility status for classes. Please check this on the Reining Australia website whilst completing entry forms.
- Exhibitors for Non Sanctioned Classes.** Riders may use one or two hands on the reins or change from one handed to two handed throughout the performance.
- Exhibitors for Sanctioned Classes-** Owners and riders competing in sanctioned events must be current financial members of the National Reining Horse Association and Reining Australia and all

horses must be licensed with the NRHA. Any transfers of ownership need to be completed by the NRHA prior to showing. **A copy of horse competition license and NRHA Membership card must be presented with the entry form:**

17. Please ensure your memberships are current and horse licences are current. It is preferable that this paperwork is completed in a timely fashion prior to competition through the Reining Australia Secretary.
18. **Biosecurity: Horse Health Declaration Form:** This form must be completed and submitted with entry. Please remember to put your Property Identification Number (PIC) on this form.
19. **Green Rider Event** All competitors will start as Green Rider Level 1 until they attain the required number of points in that category. To be eligible for the program a competitor needs to be a Non Pro. Riders may use a horse without the restriction of ownership as defined under the non pro conditions. Green Rider Level 1 & 2 will be run concurrently; competitors can only compete in one level.
20. **Green Rider Level 1** Open to any rider holding valid RA Green Rider card and has less than \$100 in RA lifetime earnings, all categories, has less than twenty five (25) lifetime Youth points and less than fifty (50) Green Rider points.
21. **Green Rider Level 2** Open to any rider holding valid RA Green Rider card and has less than \$100 in RA lifetime earnings, all categories, has less than twenty five (25) lifetime Youth points, more than 50 Green Rider points and less than 100 (100) Green points. Once a rider is not eligible for Rookie Level 1 they are automatically ineligible for the Green Rider program as of the 1st January.
22. Riders competing in the Reining Australia Green Rider program as part of the Autumn Rein Ribbon Show Programme, must be current members of this program to compete in the Green Rider classes.
23. In any case, all riders beginners to advanced must be members of an affiliate club and linked to Reining Australia either with full membership or through the Green rider programme. Please refer to Reining Australia website.
24. The working order for all classes will be drawn, and will be as per the program.
25. Any dog/s must be kept under control with a lead. **NO** dogs allowed in grandstand, marshalling area or in vicinity of food preparation areas. **Please be respectful and clean up after your dog.**
26. Horses & riders that are entered for more than one event, in a concurrent run class, will only have one run, pay one judges fee, one video fee and the score will count for both events. © designates a concurrent class.
27. At the completion of the show, stables must be left in a clean and presentable state. If stables are deemed to be left unclean, a \$50 stable cleaning fee will be invoiced to the competitor. Any outstanding stable cleaning fees will prevent a competitor from showing at subsequent shows.
28. By making an entry, you are assuming responsibility for the legal binding, of owner, rider and/or agent to the terms and conditions, as set out in the **Liability Waiver** provided with SQRHA membership forms and Reining Australia membership forms.
