



GIICS Essay Award 2017

Awards of USD 4,000 for an original thesis on offshore insurance

The GIICS Executive Committee is looking for written submissions on the insurance industry of one, or more, of the 18 jurisdictions represented by the member regulators of the Group of International Insurance Centre Supervisors.

Entries must be sent to the GIICS Secretary at chall@gfsc.gg by 31 December 2017. Awards will be made on, or around, 31 January 2018.

Submissions must be:

- No more than 10,000 words in length, excluding annexes;
- Written in English;
- Without promotional content;
- A presentation of objective evidence and/or an original argument;
- Unpublished (participants are free to publish essays elsewhere after the award); and
- Based on publicly available information.





The GIICS Essay Award is open to anybody. Awards will either be USD 1,000 or USD 4,000 at the ExCo's discretion. No more than two awards can be made each year. The GIICS ExCo reserves the right not to make any awards in a year if essays do not meet the required standard. Award winners will be named on the GIICS website.
