These involve more than 70,000 people as participants, volunteers, and audience members.

Awards & Trophies

All award recipients must reside in, or attend a school within, the Evergreen School Division boundaries. Competitors not meeting this requirement are only eligible for provincial recommendations.

1. **Kiwanis Trophy** - there will be a Trophy class for selected winners of instrumental, piano, vocal and/or speech classes which will be performed on May 1, 2019. Upon adjudicator's recommendation, there may be 3 representatives chosen from the piano classes, 3 from the instrumental classes, 3 from the vocal classes, 2 from the speech classes and 2 from the Dance classes to compete in this Trophy Class. This Trophy Class will be limited to individual performers or groups of no larger than 4 members. The winner of this class will be announced at the Hi-Lites concert. The winner shall also receive a \$200.00 cash award.
2. **Rotary Trophy** - best performance in speech classes (choir)
3. **Minerva Ladies Aid Trophy** - best performance in speech, Grades 1 – 4
4. **Baker Law Trophy** – best performance in speech, Grades 5 and up
5. **Kinsmen Trophy** - best performance in Orff
6. **Westshore Singers** - best vocal performance, 12 years and under
7. **Evergreen School Division #22 Trophy** - best performance in school choirs, Grades K - 8
8. **Noventis Credit Union Trophy** - best choral performance, open
9. **Noventis Credit Union Trophy** – best dance performance, open
10. **Noventis Credit Union Trophy** – best performance in school dance
11. **St. Michael's Catholic Women's League Trophy** - best vocal performance, 13 years and over
12. **Bayview Evangelical Free Church Trophy** - best vocal performance in sacred music
13. **RM of Gimli Trophy** - best performance in piano classes, Grades 1 - 3
14. **Piano Trophy** – best performance in piano classes, Grades 4 - 6
15. **Town of Winnipeg Beach Trophy** - best performance in piano classes, Grades 7 and up
16. **Evergreen Festival Trophy** - best performance in instrumental
17. **Lilja Martin Scholarships** – two scholarships of \$50.00 each will be awarded to deserving piano students who have demonstrated passion and interest in piano

18. **Johannes Palsson Memorial Scholarship** - Scholarship of approximately \$250.00 will be awarded to a student of Grade 5 level or higher who is currently taking piano or violin lessons. The recipient of this scholarship will be based on adjudicator's recommendation.
19. **Riverton Elks International Music Camp Scholarship** - One scholarship will be awarded to a participant between the ages of 12 and 18 who has entered the Festival for more than one year. Selected recipients shall have entered a minimum of two classes in his/her respective field of study. Adjudicator(s) shall choose the winner of this \$250.00 scholarship.
20. **Noventis Credit Union Awards** – 5 awards will be presented to ensembles participating in Speech, Orff, Vocal/Choral, Instrumental Band, and Dance
21. **CIBC Award** – best fiddle performance as recommended by the adjudicator
22. **Band – Special Merit Award** upon adjudicator's recommendation
23. All performances at Hi-Lites Concert not receiving a trophy will receive a special certificate to recognize their participation (**Certificate of Achievement**).
24. **Dance Scholarship** – awarded to a student age 10 or over to attend a suitable dance camp of their choosing

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are in addition to the rules and regulations in the AMAF Provincial Syllabus.

1. ALL AWARD RECEIPIENTS MUST RESIDE IN, OR ATTEND A SCHOOL WITHIN THE EVERGREEN SCHOOL DIVISION BOUNDARIES. COMPETITORS NOT MEETING THIS REQUIREMENT ARE ONLY ELIGIBLE FOR PROVINCIAL RECOMMENDATIONS.
2. Marks will be announced only for the top two participants in each class.
3. After the Festival entry list is closed, the executive will arrange the order of classes. The approximate time of each competition and order of competing will be shown in the Official program which will be on sale prior to the Festival and during the Festival.
NO CHANGE IN PROGRAMMING WILL BE PERMITTED AFTER MARCH 1, 2019.
4. A chord may be given on piano at the commencement of a cappella music.
5. Any person or group wishing to enter the Festival who cannot find an appropriate class description to accommodate an entry may contact Larry Moore (389-3086) to discuss the possibility of adding further classes.
6. It is the intention of the Evergreen Festival of the Arts to encourage participation in all our classes; all classes will, however, be judged on a competitive basis except in the Orff and Band sections where marks are not given. Trophies will be awarded upon adjudicator's recommendation.
7. A classroom choir, speech or choral, is expected to include every member of the class. If it is not possible to have every member participate, then 90% of the class should do so. If the school does not wish to follow this regulation, then it is probable that they will be entering for adjudication only. Classroom Choirs will enter according to grade level. Mixed grades will enter according to the average age or grade of the choir.
8. The K-3 Speech Choir classes will be all NON-COMPETITIVE. Please note that this is for the speech choir classes only, Kindergarten to Grade 3. Note: All speech choirs, competitive and non-competitive, are eligible for the Rotary Trophy (best performance in speech)
9. **Photocopied/handwritten material will not be accepted in any music class except:**
Where an entrant produces a letter from the publisher giving permission to photocopy.
Photocopied/handwritten material will not be accepted in any speech class unless:
Prior permission has been obtained from the festival.
10. Where Own Selections are used in Speech Arts classes, entrant MUST submit TWO TYPED copies of each selection with their entry form. The name and page of the text from which their selection is taken, as well as the author of the poem, play or prose excerpt, should be given.
THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.
11. For all SOLO own choice Speech selections, participants may not perform the same selection in more than one class in the same festival year, OR in any other class in subsequent festival years.
12. Instrumental performance may be performed with or without accompaniment depending upon the competitor's preference.
13. Taped accompaniment will not be permitted in any music class at the local festival, with the exception of Class MK 7603.
14. Electronic amplification will not be permitted except where specified for contemporary music and Orff.
15. **THE FESTIVAL REQUESTS THAT SCHOOLS DO NOT COPY EITHER THE PARTICIPATION OR AWARD CERTIFICATES.**

COPYRIGHT REGULATIONS

Copyright protects a work from reproduction by any means, mechanical or otherwise. Therefore, photocopying, re-typing, typesetting music using a computer program, handwriting, and all other means of reproduction are **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN**.

THE AMAF NOW HAS A LICENSE WITH CANCEOPY!

This license allows Associated Manitoba Arts Festivals and festival participants to photocopy difficult-to-obtain Speech Arts selections for performance in a festival, without penalty and without requiring prior (and sometimes equally difficult-to-obtain) permission from the copyright holder. The CANCEOPY license allows participants to make photocopies from the current AMAF Speech Arts Manual As long as the selection does not appear on the exclusion list. The CANCEOPY license also permits participants to photocopy their own choice selections not included in the Speech Arts Manual. The use of photocopies is restricted to preparation for, and participation in an AMAF affiliated festival. The exclusion list is included with the Speech Arts Manuals. Any piece from the exclusion list would need to have the original handed in to the adjudicator.

MUSICIANS, PLEASE NOTE:

Use of unauthorized photocopies shall not be accepted by adjudicators, whether it is used by the participants, accompanist, or to be handed in to the adjudicator. Participants found using unauthorized photocopies shall not be adjudicated. To avoid conflict between adjudicator and participants, it shall be the festival's responsibility to disqualify participants. In certain circumstances, the adjudicators may have to bring the incident to the attention of the Festival Committee, but the committee shall assume responsibility in this area.

Please order your music selections early. Information is in the Provincial Syllabus.

THE USE OF PHOTOCOPIED MUSIC IS AGAINST THE LAW.

Exceptions to this rule are:

Whim the participant or school provides documentation of:

- (1) Expiration of copyright
- (2) Proof of order
- (3) Letter of permission from the publisher.

Adjudicators

Ashley Wolfe - Dance Adjudicator

Ashley Wolfe started dancing at the age of 2, taking ballet classes with Rita Jamieson in Winnipeg, MB. She started her Irish dance lessons at the age of 9 after going to see and falling in love with Riverdance!

She began taking lessons through Brady Academy of Irish Dance, and completed and performed at events such as Folklorama, Canada Day, and she has also danced for the Manitoba Premier Gary Filmon.

Ashley began teaching Irish Dance in 2007, and loves to mix things up by combining traditional Irish Steps with new upbeat music, and creating fun character pieces! Her students love to compete at the Manitoba Dance Festival and other competitions both in Canada and the U.S.

Millie Hildebrand ~Vocal/Choral

Millie Hildebrand has enjoyed a lifelong involvement as a music educator and performer. Familiar to Manitoba's community as a teacher, choral director, voice instructor and festival adjudicator, she has taught classroom and choral music at all levels and has been active in implementing programs for young musicians throughout the province and in the Steinbach community where she has lived for 32 years. These have included collaborations with the University of Manitoba, the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra, the International Peace Gardens Music Camps, regional and provincial honour choirs, numerous choir tours, many musicals and a two-year teaching post in Bucharest, Romania. Going back "a few years",

Millie's performance history includes productions with Manitoba Opera, Winnipeg Mennonite Theatre, the Oregon Bach Festival Chorus, and Canzona, to name a few. She recently completed her seventh year as director of the Faith and Life Women's Chorus, and is often seen sharing the podium with husband Ed, with whom she co-conducted the U of M Concert Choir for four years.

Millie is past president of the Manitoba Choral Association, sits on the board of the Women's Musical Club of Winnipeg, and has enjoyed her work as Faculty Advisor with the U of M through the past decade. She looks forward to directing the Provincial Honour Choir in February as well as adjudicating more festivals in this spring season. When away from their music posts, Millie and Ed occupy themselves with family, their garden, and their travel "bucket list

Muriel Smith ~ Speech

Singing teacher, writer and performer Muriel Smith holds a Bachelor of Music from the University of Western, Ontario, a Licentiate in Vocal Performance from Trinity College, UK, and a Master of Arts degree in Vocal Studies and a PhD in Musicology from the University of York, UK. While living for over a decade in England Muriel maintained a vibrant private voice studio, and taught voice and speech arts at numerous theatre and secondary schools. Her students have gone on to study at the major music and theatre academies in the UK, and have performed in various touring, television, film and West-end productions. Since her return to Canada, she has adjudicated at festivals and scholarship competitions, lectured at the University of Manitoba and Providence University College, and has written and performed monologues in Winnipeg venues. She is currently writing a book about the influence of the Manitoba Registered Music Teachers' Association on culture in Manitoba over the past one hundred years.

Darryl Friesen ~ Piano

Pianist Darryl Friesen has given acclaimed performances as a soloist and collaborative artist across Canada, the United States, Europe, China, and Brazil, and has been featured numerous times in concert on CBC Radio. He has performed with the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra, Winnipeg Chamber Music Society, and has appeared on the Virtuosi recital series. Darryl completed his DMA at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign in 2009 as a fellowship student of Fulbright scholar Dr. William Heiles and Dennis Helmrich. After studying with distinguished pedagogue Lee Kum-Sing at the Vancouver Academy of Music, he received BM and MM degrees in piano performance from the University of Manitoba as a student of well-known Canadian pianist David Moroz. In great demand as a soloist, collaborative artist, teacher and clinician, he holds the position of Sessional Instructor at the University of Manitoba's Desautels Faculty of Music. He is also a faculty member at the celebrated Morningside Music Bridge program and the Rosamunde Summer Music Academy, where he works as a collaborative artist and coach. He and his wife live with their four children in Winnipeg.

Karen Tole-Henderson ~ Orff

Karen is an Elementary Music Specialist and the former Music Coordinator for the Louis Riel School Division. Karen has her Orff Specialist Certificate and has completed the Orff Levels Teacher Training Mentorship Program through Carl Orff Canada. She holds a Bachelor of Music and a Bachelor of Education from the University of Manitoba. Karen is actively involved with many music education organizations including the Manitoba Music Educators' Association. She is a founding member of Renaissance Voices, a choir that specializes in performing a cappella music. Karen enjoys a busy family life with her husband Scott and two boys, Sean and Alex.

Brian Boggs ~ Instrumental

Brian has been involved with music performance and music education for over 35 years, as a High School and University teacher as well as a performer in a variety of ensembles. Most of his early training and teaching has been in Manitoba and Saskatchewan. He held a DND music teaching position in Lahr, Germany for 3 years and has been in Ottawa since 1984. Brian is experienced with a variety of musical ensembles, both as a performer and a music director since 1976 including concert bands from beginners to advanced, marching bands, jazz ensembles and, in particular (50) musical theatre stage productions. He has performed with a wide variety of ensembles from the Lakehead Symphony orchestra to rock and jazz groups. Mr. Boggs received a B. Mus. Ed. from Brandon University and was also enrolled in the M.Mus. Ed program at U.W.O in London where he conducted the Symphonic Band and the Clarinet Choir. He has been active in his career as a festival adjudicator and clinician for a variety of instrumental events and has been actively involved with music education at the senior level through provincial curriculum writing and dedicated arts advocacy initiatives.

At present he plays professionally in the Ottawa area (woodwinds) and is a consultant and workshop instructor for music programs in the area, as well as a private teacher for senior students. He also plays with several community groups including a rhythm and blues band, Orpheus theatre, jazz big bands and pit orchestras for musicals. Mr. Boggs is also a member of several professional music associations and committees. He is very proud to have worked with many students who have gone on to professional careers in music education or the music and arts industry across Canada and the U.S.
