

PhD position available

The Laboratory for Immunological and Molecular Cancer Research in Salzburg/Austria (LIMCR, www.limcr.at) seeks a candidate for a 3 year PhD position in B cell immunology/lymphoma research. Salary will be according to the guidelines of the Austrian science fund (www.fwf.ac.at). The candidate will investigate the regulation of AID/APOBECs in B cells and B cell lymphoma with a particular focus on its contribution to clonal evolution/chemo resistance in chronic lymphocytic leukemia. The project will comprise analysis of a lymphoma mouse model, NGS sequencing and genetic analyses of cell lines, mouse samples and primary lymphoma samples.

The LIMCR is part of the 3rd medical department of the Paracelsus Medical University Salzburg. It offers a collaborative environment consisting of clinicians and biologists, it provides access to primary blood samples, is attached to an SPF animal facility and endowed with a comprehensive support infrastructure. Furthermore, the LIMCR is part of the Cancer Cluster Salzburg (CCS, www.cancercluster-salzburg.at), which constitutes a synergistic interdisciplinary research network for breaking new grounds in cancer research.

Applicants must hold a Master's degree, should have good presentation skills and a strong background in tumor biology/immunology/biochemistry or genetics.
