    - Explanation of 'Greatest Progress' portion of the handout
      - We are excelling in ELA
      - We are doing well in Math, and we are making strides to continue to improve
    - Explanation of 'Greatest Needs'
      - Suspension was addressed
        - MTSS, PBIS-addressing intervention before suspension
    - The 'Goals' are addressing the greatest need
    - 'Career Pathways/CTE Integrated into Actions', addresses discussion at the LCAP community meeting
