



BEACH AND POOL RULES

General

- Guards have the authority to close the beach when weather or ocean conditions make being in the water hazardous. Guards also have the authority to remove anyone who is disruptive or is not complying with policy requiring orderly and proper conduct.
- Glass containers and vehicles are not permitted on the beach
- Pets are not permitted on the beach from May 15 – October 1.
- All trash shall be deposited in the receptacles provided.
- Swimmers swim at their own risk.
- Specific rules are posted at each beach crossing.
- From Memorial Day to Labor Day, canopies and tent-like structures must be positioned no closer to the water than midway from the dune fencing to the waterline, and no closer together than 10 feet apart. Exceptions are made at the Beach Captain's discretion. Infant cabanas are exempt.

Beach Rules

1. Obey lifeguards at all times.
2. Use caution in the surf.
3. Glass bottles and containers are not allowed.
4. Balls, Frisbees, etc., are not allowed in the water or on the beach during crowded periods. Lifeguards may exercise discretion at other times.
5. Kite flying is not allowed during guarded hours.
6. Surfing and fishing are not allowed during guarded hours.
7. Radios and musical instruments are to be kept at low levels.
8. Pets are not allowed on the beach from 5/15 - 10/1.
9. Crafts requiring oars/paddles are not allowed (with the exception of the surf rescue craft).
10. Hard fiberglass coated body boards, kneeboards and skim boards are not allowed during guarded hours.
11. Rafts and boogie boards of soft construction are permitted at the lifeguard's discretion.
12. Holes deeper than 2 feet are prohibited. Use of a metal shovel is not allowed.
13. Private umbrellas are the responsibility of the owner. No umbrella is to be left unattended. Also, umbrellas must be set in such a manner to avoid being uprooted in windy conditions.
14. From Memorial Day to Labor Day, canopies and tent-like structures must be positioned no closer to the water than midway from the dune fencing to the waterline, and no closer together than 10 feet apart. Exceptions are made at the Beach Captain's discretion. Infant cabanas are exempt.
15. Bonfires are strictly prohibited.
16. Sea Colony owner picture IDs or guest badges must be displayed at all times.

POOLS

- Guards have the authority to close the pool. They also have the authority to remove anyone who is disruptive or is not complying with policy requiring orderly and proper conduct.
- Swimmers swim at their own risk.
- Specific rules are posted at each pool. Please read them before using the pool and comply with them.
- Pool hours are subject to change without notice, so check with your lifeguard for schedule changes.

POOL RULES

1. No swimming unless a lifeguard is on duty and in place.
2. Shower before entering the pool.
3. No diving in pools allowed.
4. No flips or jumping backwards into pool.
5. Children under the age of twelve must be accompanied by an adult not less than 18 years of age.
6. Non-swimmers who use flotation devices as a means of support must remain in the shallow end of the pool and be accompanied by a swimming adult.
7. No running or rough play.
8. No carrying of any persons on the shoulders.
9. No inconsiderate behavior of any nature.
10. No foul language.
11. No diapers. Incontinent persons and non-toilet trained children must wear a tight fitting swimsuit or rubber under garments that seal tightly around the legs and waist. Incontinent persons and non-toilet trained children are not permitted in the main pool at T-4.

12. No glass containers allowed in pool area.
13. Proper swimming attire must be worn in the pool. Cut-offs and street attire not permitted in pool (except white T-shirt to protect from sun exposure).
14. Use of pool toys such as balls, squirt guns, swim fins, dive rings, dive sticks, rafts, boogie boards and inner-tubes will be at the discretion of the lifeguard who will consider such factors as appropriateness of play, safety, and bather load.
15. All participants must have owner or guest badges to use pool facilities.
16. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, or discharging of bodily wastes in the pools or spa is strictly prohibited.
17. Any persons having an infectious or communicable disease are prohibited from using a public pool or spa.
18. Persons having open blisters, cuts, etc., are advised not to use the pools or spa.
19. No pets allowed in the pool areas.
20. Individuals in non-compliance with these rules may be asked to leave the pool area by the lifeguard and/or Security.
