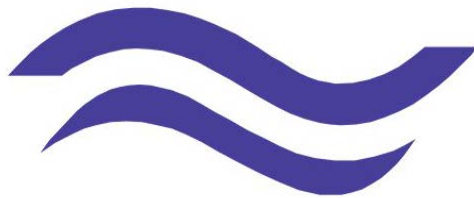
# Notice Of Race

**2018 International Finn East Coast Championships**

**3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> of March 2018**

The Venue and organising authority is

**Woollahra Sailing Club- 2 Vickery Avenue, Rose Bay.**



## 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing including the special regulations and prescriptions of Yachting Australia and the International Finn Association Class Rules.
- 1.2 All boats shall comply with the requirements of the Australian Sailing Special Regulations for Off the Beach Boats.
- 1.3 Rule 42 is changed such that the Race Committee may permit pumping, ooching and rocking when the consistent wind exceeds 10 knots in accordance with Class Rules and Sailing Instructions.

## 2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 All Competitors may be required to display Event sponsor's name(s)/Logo(s) and bow numbers. If required, the organising authority will supply these items and they shall be fixed and/or worn as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2 Advertising is permitted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20

## 3 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the International Finn Class that fulfil the following requirements:
- 3.2 Each shall be a member of a club affiliated with their respective State Yachting Association. Attention is drawn to RRS 46 and 55.
- 3.3 Each boat shall comply with the International Finn Class Rules. There will be no measurement at registration however the race committee reserves the right to conduct spot checks.
- 3.4 Entries close at 1700hrs Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> of March 2018. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority, but subject to a late entry surcharge.

## 4 FEES

- 4.1 Regatta entry is \$100 (inc. GST) per boat payable to Woollahra Sailing Club.
- 4.2 The late entry surcharge is \$25.

## 5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 A maximum of 6 races will be conducted for the series
- 5.2 No Warning Signal will be made after 1500hrs on the last scheduled day of racing

## 6 MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 It is the responsibility of each skipper to ensure their boat complies with the International Finn Class Rules.

## **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 7.1 The sailing instructions will be available from the Woollahra Sailing Club Office from 1700hrs Thursday 1<sup>th</sup> of March 2018.

## **8 COURSES**

- 8.1 The course to be sailed will be a windward/leeward configuration or as otherwise described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 8.2 Racing will be conducted on the waters of Sydney Harbour.

## **9 SCORING**

- 9.1 Three (3) races are required to constitute a series.
- 9.2 When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.3 When five (5) or more races have been completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **10 SUPPORT BOATS**

- 10.1 Support boats shall be marked with the burgee or initials of their home club/state.

## **11 PRIZES**

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded to boats finishing 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> on scratch and at the discretion of the Race Committee.

## **12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 12.1 It is the competitor's decision to enter the Event or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in the Event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. By way of entry in the Event competitors shall indemnify the Organising Authorities, and the Host Club, their Officers, Members, Staff and Agents in respect to all claims and demands of whatever nature which may be made upon them in connection with or howsoever arising from their participation or intended participation in the Event.
- 12.2 The Organising Authorities, and the Host Sailing Club, their Officers, Members, Staff and Agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in the Event or howsoever arising in connection with the Event.
- 12.3 **Competitors attention is drawn to RRS 4 – Decision to Race**

## **13 INSURANCE**

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance cover of not less than AUD\$5,000,000 or equivalent thereof in any other currency for any accident.
