Please do not register unless you plan on attending as we purchase supplies and staff by our registration numbers.

Camp Grace is open to the public; you do not have to be a GCA student to attend.

- The cost of Summer Camp is \$165.00 per week for each student (if they attend 1 day or up to 5 days).
- There is a 5% discount for all additional children.
- All payments are made to GCA and must be received on **Monday morning** or student may not attend camp. Also, no student will be able to return the following Monday if the account is not current.
- There will be no refunds for days not used.
- There will not be any drop-ins allowed.
- Summer camp fees are in addition to your regular FACTS tuition fees if applicable. Students are required to bring a sack lunch. Morning and afternoon snacks will be provided.

Medications are encouraged to be given at home. However, should your child need to take medication while at Summer camp the following must be followed.

- The parent must request in person that the student be given the medication.
- The parent must sign a release form allowing preschool personnel to administer the medication.
- Medication Authorization forms are only valid for a one week period, unless medication is held for allergic reaction reasons.
- Medication must be in the original container with the pharmacy/manufactures label attached.
- Medication will be administered according to the prescription label which should match instructions given in writing by the parent.
- The parent must provide all needed items to administer the medication such as medicine dropper, cup or spoon, etc. School does not provide these items for sanitary purposes.
- If the label states to administer medication (including breathing treatments) two times per day unless specific times are listed on the prescription and that time falls during Summer camp hours we will not administer the medication.
- If the label states to administer medication (including breathing treatments) three times per day, we will only administer the medication/breathing treatment one time per day.
- Students **WILL NOT** be allowed to transport medication.
