

# Not-So-Last-Minute-Lariat

**Skill Level:** Beginner

## **Finished Measurements**

36½" (92.7cm) long X little over ¼"  
(0.64cm) wide

**Yarn:** Lion Brand Flikka, 50% Cotton, 50% Polyester, 7g, 14yds (12.8m), Sport Weight, 1 skein, Toucan, #701 (reds) OR Dill Pickle, #705 (greens)

**Needles:** US7 (4.5mm) – double pointed needles (dpns)

**Notions:** Pendant [2" (5.08cm) long X 1½" (3.81cm) wide, hole length: 1" (2.54cm), Tapestry Needle

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## Key:

cco - cable cast on

ktbl - knit through back loop

k - knit

k2togfb - knit 2 together

through front and back

sts - stitches

RS - right side

## Gauge in pattern (before blocking):

4 stitches = little over ¼"

(0.64cm)

## Pattern:

ktbl, k2togfb, k1

## Instructions:

1. cco 4 sts
2. work pattern
3. move stitches to RS of needle
4. on RS of work, repeat (2) and (3) until lariat measures 36½" (92.7cm) from cast on edge
5. bind off stitches
6. run lariat through pendant hole, flat side (i.e. RS) facing up - pendant should rest in the middle of the lariat
7. tie knot
8. whipstitch ends of pendant together
9. weave in ends

**Note:** You are always working on RS of lariat.
