FIRST AMENDMENT TO EMERGENCY MASTER SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR PREPA'S
ELECTRICAL GRID REPAIRS – HURRICANE MARIA

APPEAR

AS FIRST PARTY: The Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (PREPA), a public corporation and government instrumentality of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, created by Act 83 of May 2, 1941, as amended, represented in this act by its Executive Director, Ricardo Luis Ramos Rodriguez, of legal age, married, engineer and resident of Caguas, Puerto Rico.-----

AS SECOND PARTY: Whitefish Energy Holdings, LLC (Whitefish) a partnership organized and existing under the laws of the state of Montana, United States of America, with a place of business at 144 Aspen Ridge Wa, Whitefish, MT 59937, herin represented by Andy Techmanski, of legal age, married, and a resident of Montana, (hereinafter referred to collectively as "the contractor") whose authority of representation is evidenced by corporate resolution.-----



WHEREAS: According to the original terms of the Agreement PREPA disbursed the amount of \$3,700,000 for mobilization of personnel and equipment. The Agreement did not include the maximum amount of to be paid. However, as authorized by PREPA's Governing Board Resolution, the parties agree to amend and supersede the Agreement dated September 26, 2017 to comply with the Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA) for the emergency repairs of the electrical infrastructure under the following:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ARTICLE 1: NON DISCLOSURE

Under United States Judicial Code [10 U.S. Code § 836 - Art. 36](#) no member of the team may speak to any media, relationship, external or internal entity not directly associated with the project chain of command. Under penalty of law, this act will be enforced with extreme methods if deemed necessary.

ARTICLE 2: CONTAINMENT ENCLOSURE

The Contractor shall provide labor, supervision, tools, and expertise to create the 174 acre terrestrial and aquatic ENCLOSURE. The ENCLOSURE must be able to evidence a yield strength of ~220ksi with a tensile strength of no less than 225ksi. It must have <12% strain to failure.

The height of the ENCLOSURE must be no less than 400 feet in height. The ENCLOSURE must provide:

- 1700k volt output SHOCK
- NxRA / Ultrax CLARA Hybrid-Reactive Armor of no less than 30mm with defense against KE threats of up to 270kg/m²
- Full sensory net including thermal, radiological, and chemical/biological contaminants.
- Scatter-pattern randomized mine: 5kg RDX in penetrator configuration

ARTICLE 3: SCIENCE MODULE

The Contractor will provide a SCIENCE LAB capable of geological, biological, and chemical analysis. This laboratory will have:

- Atmospheric sealant. BLS-4 compliant, positive-pressure suit enabled.
- Hardened networked computer system. Air-Gap for security.
- Encrypted satellite uplink.
- On-Site Supply of Crimean-Congo hemorrhagic fever sterilization option (central air supply)
- Security doors and check-points.
- Informational air-lock for external security personnel.



ARTICLE 4: RESPONSE CONTRACTORS

The Contractor will provide 200 elite para-military rated 1994 psychographic Twentynine Palms WILL FIRE POSITIVE. The Contractor will provide LMG, SMG, and HMG as well as 5 rotary wing aircraft, night vision, thermal vision, and radioactive sensor suite.

Cadre of NON-ENGLISH SPEAKING troops required for SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT. Russian preferred.

Troops trained in handling of CHEM WEAPONS are required. Will be supplied with VX/SMALLPX supplies in case of PLAN B.

ARTICLE 5: MARINE EXOBIOLOGIST (MEXOB)

[NAME REDACTED] will be delivered to the SCIENCE MODULE under black-out protocol. Subject is to be held under guard at all times by NON-ENG operators with instructions from CENTRAL CONTROL. Secondary medical personnel will be kept in RESERVE LOCATION for physiological, medical, and psychological screening of MEXOB.

ARTICLE 6: FEED CREW

The Contractor will maintain staff with expertise in the handling of human remains and trauma victims as well as operating medically-designated vehicles for transport from hospitals / countryside to ENCLOSURE. This crew will travel with RESPONSE CONTRACTORS.

The Contractor will provide amphetamines for 24-7 shift and with the capability of moving 100 bodies living or dead each day. FEED CREW will have 15% of personnel as SCOUT DESIGNATION to seek and find suitable biomass.

- Corpse Dogs are preferred

ARTICLE 7: PLAN C

The Contractor will provide crew with expertise in handling 2MT NUCLEAR PACKAGE. Expertise in deployment, detonation, and recovery required.
