Rules & Regulations

- 1 The Exhibition is open to any artist over 16.
- 2 Only original work not previously submitted to Bury Art Festival will be accepted.
- 3 The artist must declare on the Entry Form that all works are originals. Lithographs and etchings are acceptable but colour copies, giclée prints and photographs or enhanced photographs are not.
- 4 Bury Art Festival, or its authorised representatives, reserve the right to reject, at the selection process, any work that is considered unsuitable for the exhibition.
- 5 Works must be framed appropriately for the medium. All pieces must be strung, ready for hanging. Inadequately framed items will not be displayed. No clip frames will be accepted.
- 6 Some paintings will be displayed on the gallery walls. Mirror-plate fixing will be done by the gallery.
- 7 Works must indicate the artist name, title of piece, medium and price on the back of the work. A tie-on label with all this information must also be attached to the back of the work with a string long enough to hang over the top front of the exhibit to aid screen labelling.
- 8 Works priced on the entry form may not be withdrawn from sale once accepted.
- 9 Works may not be sold for less than the catalogue price during the exhibition.
- 10 3D exhibits must be displayed by the artist in pre-allocated areas in the gallery.
- 11 In the event of a sale, Bury Art Festival will take 35% donation, unless the artist has generously offered a greater percentage.
- 12 Accepted works must remain on show for the duration of the exhibition.
- 13 Whilst every care will be taken, neither Bury Hospice nor any other persons connected with this event, directly or indirectly, can accept responsibility for loss or damage, however caused. If insurance protection is desired, then each individual artist must make his/her own arrangements and bear the cost of the premium.
- 14 The entry fee of £15 covers all works submitted. This needs to be sent in with the entry form and is non-refundable. Unsuccessful applicants' fees will be donated to Bury Hospice.
- 15 All works not collected on Sunday 19th May 2019 will be disposed of to the benefit of the charity except if otherwise advised.

 If you are a 3D artist, you will need to send four colour photographs of your work with this entry form for judging. If you are chosen to exhibit we will ring you to discuss requirements.

 In the event of a sale, Bury Art Festival will take a minimum 35% donation for Bury Hospice. If you wish to donate more than 35% enter your percentage here %

 All Artists must be available to pick up unsold artwork on Sunday 19th May 2019 between 12.00 and 2pm.
