Award winning photographer Craig McCord concentrates on fine art landscape photography. His interest in photography started in the early 1970's while serving in the Air Force. Largely self-taught in many types and styles of photography, he was influenced by black and white photography icons Ansel Adams, Bret Weston, and John Sexton among others. One can see these influences come through in the richness of tones in Craig's black and white works. Craig's style shows a fondness for wide angle perspectives. He often incorporates strong foreground elements to add a measure of depth, drawing the viewer into the image.

Selections of Craig's work reside in commercial and private collections in several states and throughout Missouri. The National Park Service selected Craig's images of the Ozark National Scenic Riverways to highlight their celebration of the Park System's centennial celebration in 2016.

Craig shares his love of photography by hosting workshops in Missouri and Kansas, as well as the Northwest, including the Oregon coast and the Grand Tetons in Wyoming. Exhibit hours are Fridays from 1:00pm to 6:00pm and Saturdays from 1:00 to 5:00pm. Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday by appointment.
