<u>Part of Speech</u>	<u>Definition</u>	<u>Word</u>	<u>Sample Sentence</u>
Noun	person, place, or thing	teacher, student, cat	I have a cat .
Pronoun	replaces a noun	she, you, her, their	Linda is pretty. She is pretty.
Verb	action	can, love, eat, sing	I love English.
Adjective	describes a noun	four, small, excited, harder	I like small dogs.

Adverb	modifies a verb, adjective or adverb	slowly, well, badly, smoothly	He reads slowly .
Articles	determines a noun	a/an, the,	Can you pass me a piece of cake. The cake is over there.
Preposition	links words and phrases	to, at, on, in	I go to school every day.
Conjunction	joins clauses, sentences, or words	and, but, when, because	I eat chicken and fish, but I don't like beef.
Interjection	an exclamation or emotion added to a sentence	oh!, ouch!, hi!, oops!	Oops! I broke the glass.
