**Distance:** 2.5 miles 4km **Time:** 1.5 hours

### On this walk you will see:

- A herd of Exmoor ponies
- Clump of beech trees known as the Seven Sisters
- Three bronze age burial mounds
- The remains of a folly tower

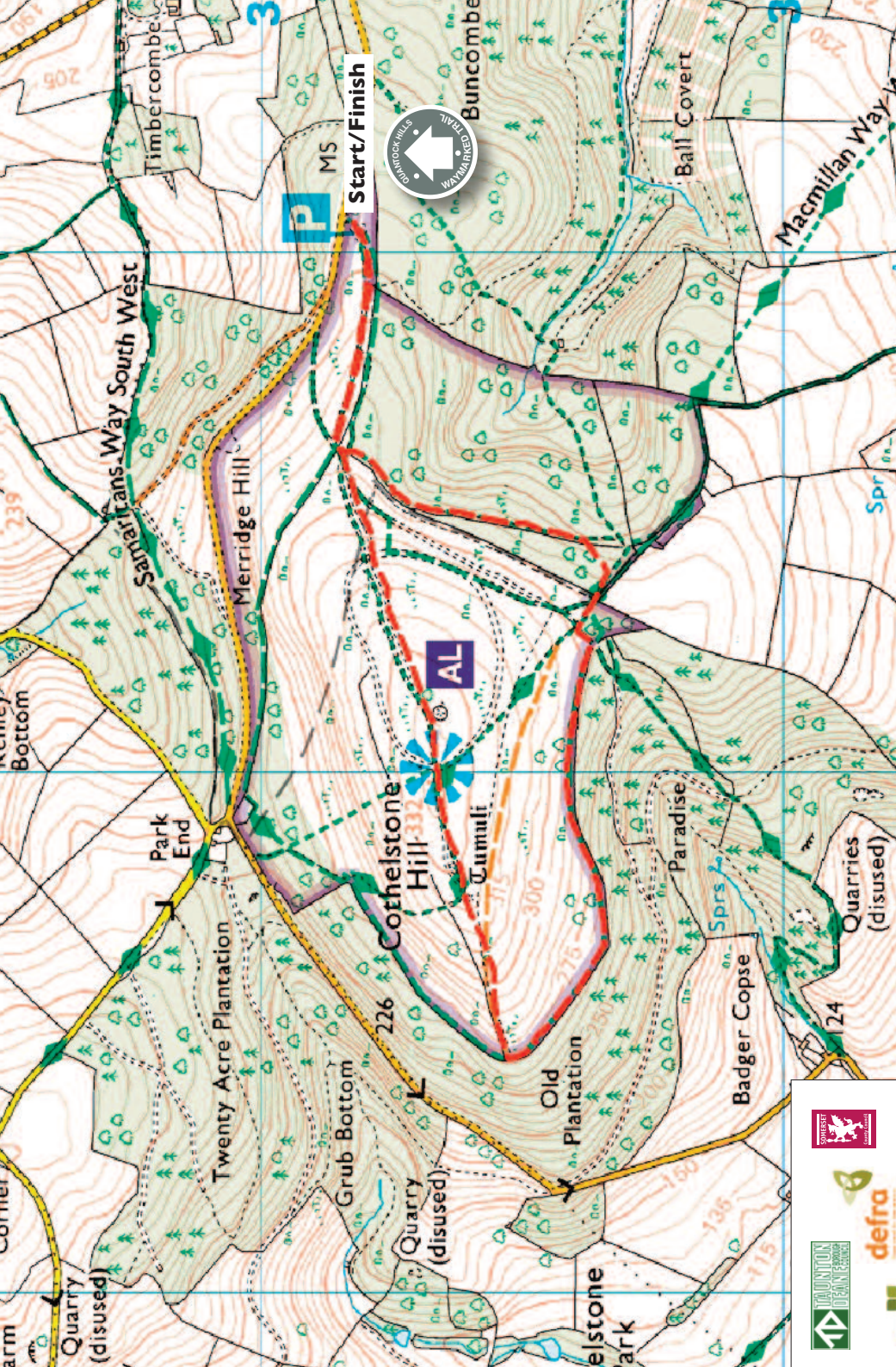
### On this walk you might see:

Our Exmoor Pony herd often cluster around the hilltop group of trees known as the Seven Sisters. In spring the woodland floor becomes alive with a carpet of bluebells. If you are lucky with the weather you will also see wonderful 360 degree views.

**Did you know?** The Exmoor pony has changed little since the Stone Age. By grazing on scrub and rough grasses, this hardy and endangered native breed is the perfect tool for keeping the hilltop in the best condition for wildlife.
