TRIAL INFORMATION

This trial will be held indoors on rubber over padding. The following is a list of obstacles to be used. Contacts have rubber coating. 2" jumps will be obtained by crossing bars on the 4" jump cups.

A-frame (6' 8" slatless) Closed (Collapsed) Tunnel Tire Jump (16") Dog walk (8' slatless ramps) Table (30" by 30")
Open (Pipe) Tunnel (16") Single & winged jumps Teeter (8' slatless, 12" wide) Weave poles (22" centers)

Warm up on TDAA equipment provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization is available each morning prior to judging.

Awards: Ribbons awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Fast track dogs will only get Qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels.

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS

All dogs must be kept on leash except in designated areas

Eligibility: This trial is open to all dogs under 20" and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. TDAA rules can be obtained online at www.k9tdaa.com

STANDARD COURSE BETA FORMAT – ALSO KNOWN AS DOUBLE RUN

Beta format is for pairs of Standard runs (1 & 2, 3 & 4, and so on) and allows you to run the same course twice in the same course order (no renumbering of obstacles, no changing the course). And yes, you can qualify twice too!

Everyone walks the course, then everyone runs the course. There is no 2nd walk-thru before round 2. If you only enter 1 round, you will still walk the course with everyone else (no separate walk-through for exhibitors only running round 2.)

Why are we offering this? Many other clubs in the area are trying this format, and exhibitors have loved it. It offers a chance to try different handling techniques on each round (did something not work, would something different work better?) – and it means less course building! We can move more quickly through the day. We think you'll love it!

GAMES DESCRIPTIONS

Cha-Cha is a game that requires the dog to earn points to the beat of the Cha-cha: two slow beats (non-jump obstacles) followed by three quick beats (jumps). This is a game of strategy and precision.

Minuet in G is a simple sequence run over and over again as a continuous loop until the expiration of time. The dog earns one point for each sequence completed. The handler must reset any dropped bar and restart the sequence on any wrong course fault.

Black Hole –is like a standard numbered course, earning points for each obstacle. The dog can continue to earn points unless the dog goes into a pipe tunnel (the black hole). Scoring stops once the dog goes off course into a tunnel.

Boston Bowling –consists of two short courses, each starting with a specific entry to one of two tunnels. The handler "bowls" his dog by sending the dog ahead into a tunnel entrance. Each dog-and-handler team has two bowls. The handler may not step over the penalty line (the start line) as she bowls her dog into one of the tunnel entrances.

Puppy Cannon –features the pipe tunnel as a test of the handler's skill when redirecting the dog. It is typically played with three (or more) small numbered sequences that can be taken in the order of the handler's choosing.

Jackpot – Jackpot is run as a two-part course. The first part consists of the handler and dog attempting to accumulate at least the minimum required points for their level, in the stated amount of time. In the second part, the handler and dog work through a series of obstacles within a time set by the judge. The handler must stay out of a designated area while the dog works within this area. The dog must execute the obstacles in the correct order, without faults and cross the finish line within the time to earn the Gamble points.

Colors -- is made up of two relatively equal numbered sequences. The handler must select one sequence to be completed by the dog. You must tell the judge prior to taking the first obstacle which "color" you intend to complete.

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Agility Class

Beginner All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Intermediate Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Classes

Games I All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games II Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) – Games & Standard Classes

TDAA offers FEO runs (at the option of the host club), open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. Maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT, cannot repeat any obstacles, and no training in the ring.

Fast Track Move-Ups: Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a “Fast Track” basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move from Beginner to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginner and again in Intermediate. Likewise, a dog may move from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower two levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog’s owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00 with your entry with the FAST TRACK portion completed. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. This fee must be paid for this trial even if a Fast Track fee has been paid in the past.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS - See www.k9tdaa.com for updates to Rules and height divisions!

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler’s option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division (and scored in that higher height division.) A judge must measure provisional dogs.

New rules effective January 1, 2015:

- **Handler/Owner selects jump height** – Each handler may select the jump height they wish their dog to jump. All jump height exemptions are now removed. Dogs will continue to be scored with dogs at their measured height.
- **Removal of four-paw safety rule** – a Beginner dog will no longer be required to move on after committing four paws to an obstacle and leaving. Beginner dogs will have three chances to perform a contact obstacle, and will not be faulted until a third on-and-off refusal.
- **Additional time for Veteran Dogs and Disabled Handlers will still apply.**
 - Veteran Dogs (7 yrs and older) receive an extension of standard course time
 - Measured height of 2” & 4” dogs receive an additional 4 seconds
 - Measured heights of 8”, 12” & 16” dogs receive an additional 2 seconds
 - Disabled Handlers receive an extension of 4 seconds to standard course times and qualifying course times for games.

Please consult your jump height card/email to confirm the correct measured height to enter.

If you do not have a TDAA height card/email your dog must be measured at this trial.

Disabled Handlers – A time exemption will be granted as above. The proof of the disability shall be the handler’s disability parking tag or other documentation. There will be no special system of titling for disabled handlers.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- * Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- * Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- * Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- * At the handler’s option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- * Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com
- * Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.

* **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

* The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or closed and it's actually fun and you learn a lot getting a different view of the trial and different handlers!

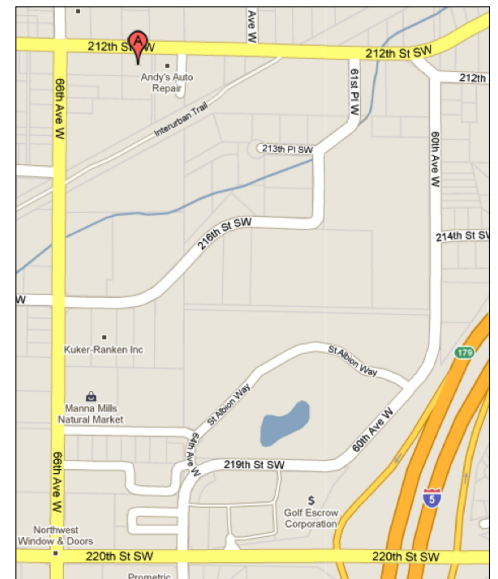
