| 1 Objective | To identify the best performing competition players |
| 2 Which competitions | All state / club competitions included in the PWA competition calendar, for the rest of this year |
| 3 Competition Ladders | There will separate competition ladders for men and women |
| 4 Ranking points | 5 points - Winner
3 points - Runner up
2 points - 3rd place - if known
1 point - 4th place - if known |
| 5 PWA State comps. | 1 point will also be awarded to the top 8 (ie 4th to 8th place) |
| 6 Women's ladder | 2 points will be awarded to the highest unplaced all womans team competing in an 'any combination' competition
1 point to second highest - if known |
| 7 Official results | It is the responsibility of the host Club to advise PWA of the official results in full |
| 8 How will points be allocated ? | Points will be allocated to an individual
eg - Each member of a winning triples team will earn 5 points |
| 9 Final ranking | Highest points total for the rest of the year
If tied, then count back the highest number of wins
If still tied , then play off between the tied players |
| 10 Trophy | A "Player of the year' trophy will be awarded to both the best man and the best woman competition player at the end of the year. |
