



Using Google Expeditions without Internet Access

Although all of the devices need to be connected to the same router/hub, the devices **do not** need to have internet access and thereby utilize bandwidth, nor allow students to browse the internet or social media on their devices during a class.

Follow these easy step by step instructions to get started:

Steps:

- 1) Connect your teacher tablet to a router *with internet access* to download the Expedition and collection of scenes for your students to visit during class (for example Machu Picchu or Underwater Caribbean).
- 2) You will know the Expedition download is complete when you see this symbol (checkmark) in the bottom right corner

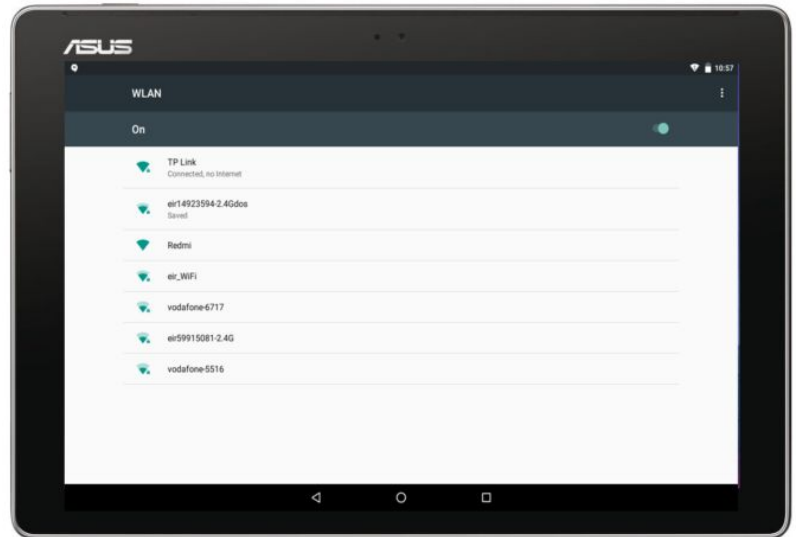


Expedition download complete

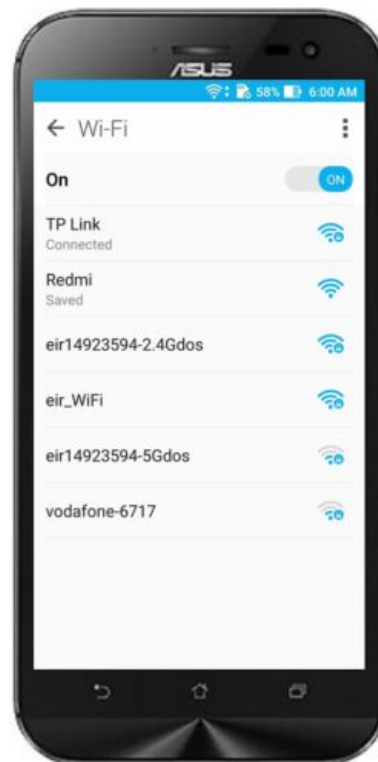
- 3) Once the Expedition has been downloaded, change the router the teacher tablet is connected to (i.e. the router *with internet access*) to the same one the students will be connected to (i.e. the TP Link router that is *not* connected to the internet).



Teacher tablet connected to a router (TP Link) without internet access.



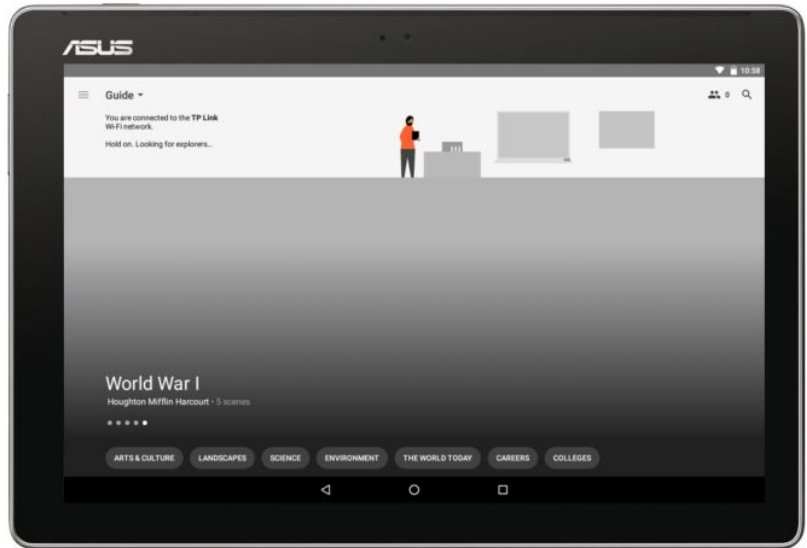
Student device connected to the same router (TP Link) without internet access.



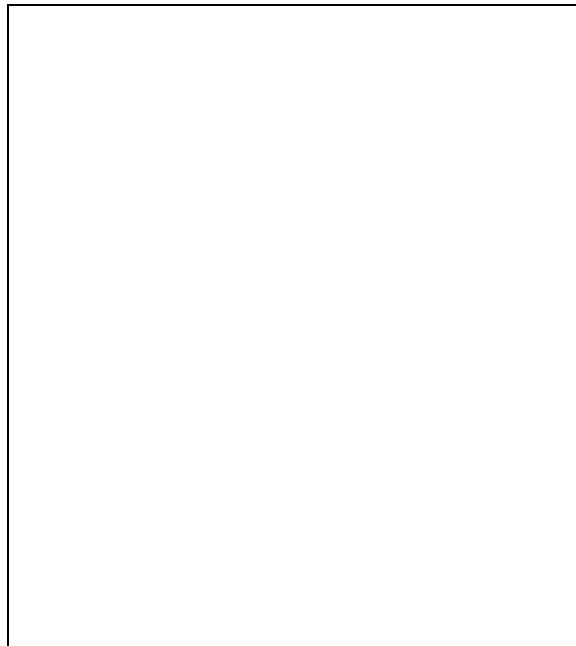


4) Open Expeditions on both the teacher tablet and student device

(no internet access)*



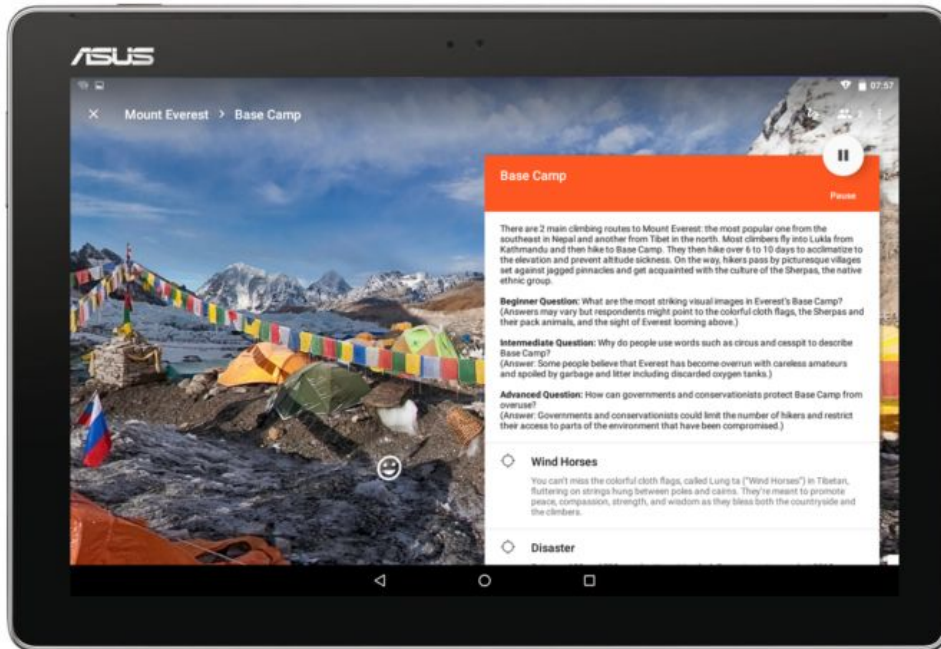
*Student device
