

West York Boys Club Scholarship

WEST YORK BOYS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

The West York Boys Club (WYBC), a non-profit organization, has established (2) \$1,000 scholarships to help finance higher education for high school seniors that participated in the West York Boys Club. This scholarship is awarded to (1) Male and (1) Female student annually. The WYBC scholarship committee will select the winning essay. The scholarship will be awarded during the “Senior Awards Assembly” each school year. There will be two scholarships available in the amount of \$1,000.

The scholarship is awarded without regard to race, color, religion, sex, disability, or national origin. The scholarship committee votes on numbered essays with all identifying individual information deleted. No member or officer will play a part in the selection if they have a relative entered in the contest.

Eligibility

Contestants must be high school seniors who are planning to enroll in a full time course of study at an accredited post secondary education program or technical school. Contestants must have also participated in a West York Boys Club program to be eligible.

Essay Topic

Contestants must submit an essay of a minimum of 250 to a maximum of 800 words on the topic:

- **How has the West York Boys Club prepared me for life in the future?**

Rules

Contestants must follow the rules within this paper in order to win the essay contest. Contestants who do not follow the rules will be disqualified.

Deadline

Essays must be turned in no later than May 6, 2019. Email essay to Dan Rice at driceii@comcast.net. We will confirm receipt of your essay. If you have any questions please call 717-278-8738.

Format Rules

-A title page must be provided separately showing the author’s name, telephone number, home address, parent’s/legal guardian’s name. The contestant should indicate his/her school guidance counselor’s name, planned field of study, and if known, the school he/she plans to attend.

-Do not place identifying information in the body of the essay such as name, school, parent’s name, etc.
