## Teacher Notes

The alphabet is broken down into sequences.  
One group for Player 1 and another for Player 2.

Each player faces one another.

The "AlphaChunks" are displayed, so everyone  
can see the list.

Choose one student to pick the 'red' letters to  
recite and one to pick the 'black' letters.

Have the students toss a ball back and forth  
while reciting the chunks one at a time.

As time progresses, the students will refer to the  
chart less and less.

When he/she is writing, they may be able to  
remember the letters in this sequence thereby  
making it easier to write the alphabet.
