| 2. Helicopters FF237 | ½ yard – 50cm |
| 3. Racing Cars FF240 | 3.½ yard – 3mtr 25cm |
| 4. Hexagons FF239 | ¾ yard – 75cm |
| 5. Cars FF238 | ½ yard – 50cm |
| 6. Arrows FF241 | 1.3/8 yard - 1.25mtr |
| 7. White | 1.1/4yds - 1.15mtr |

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut twenty six 6.1/2" squares

From fabric 2 cut twenty four 4.3/4" squares

From fabric 3 for the backing cut two pieces 68" length of fabric 3 across the width of fabric. Remove selvedge edge, and sew together along the long edge of the fabric. Cut to make a piece 68" by 68". For the binding cut five 2.1/2" lengths of fabric 3 across the width of fabric.

From fabric 4 cut twenty six 4.3/4" squares, cut and piece 2.1/2" wide strips, two 56.1/2" long and two 60.1/2" long for the border

From fabric 5 cut forty eight 3.1/2" squares

From fabric 6 cut twenty six 4.3/4" squares

From fabric 7 cut one hundred 3.7/8" squares

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances.

Sewing

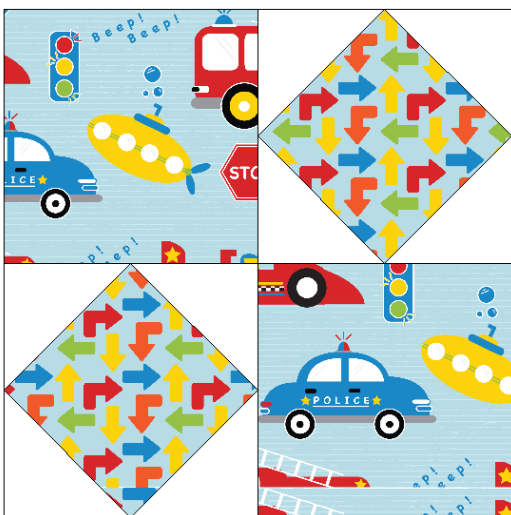
You will need to make two different quilt blocks.



Block 1

Sew the fabric 2 and fabric 4 squares together in pairs. Sew two pairs of squares together to make a four patch unit. Make twelve of these.

Cut the fabric 7 squares in half along one diagonal to make triangles. Sew two of these triangles to two adjacent sides of each fabric 5 square. Make sure that the white triangles are placed so that overall a large triangle is formed. Sew one of these large triangles to each edge of the four patch unit created from fabrics 2 and 4. Make twelve of block 1.



Block 2

Cut the fabric 7 squares in half along one diagonal to create triangles. Sew one triangle to each edge of a fabric 6 square. Make twenty six of these. Sew each one to a fabric 1 square. Sew two of these pairs of squares together to make a four patch unit. Take care to place them so that the fabric 1 squares are diagonally opposite each other. Make thirteen of block 2.

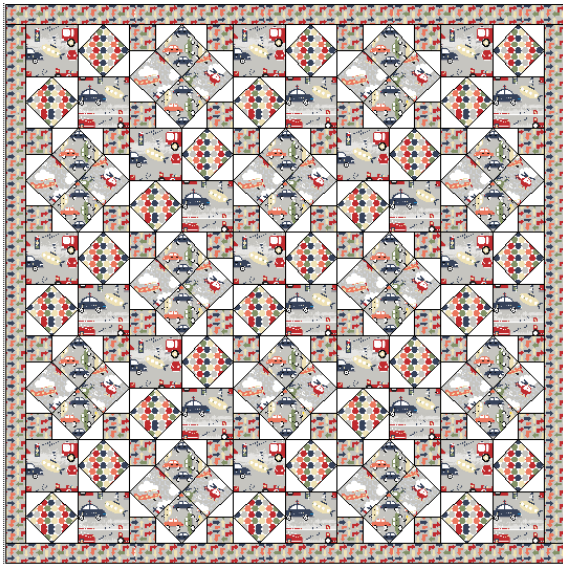
Assembling the Zoom Quilt

You will have 25 quilt blocks altogether. Lay them out in five rows of five. Begin row 1 with quilt block 1 and then alternate the blocks across the row. Begin row 2 with quilt block 2 and then alternate the blocks across the row. Continue to make the rows, alternating the first block of each row so that the blocks alternate across the rows and down the columns of the quilt. Sew them together in five rows of five.

For the border sew the two 56.1/2" lengths of fabric 4 to the sides of the quilt and sew the two 60.1/2" strips to the top and bottom.

For the backing fabric you will need 68" squares of both backing fabric 3 and wadding.

For the binding, sew the five strips of fabric 3 together to give one very long strip to make the binding.



Zoom Quilt 2

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut twenty six 6.1/2" squares

From fabric 2 cut twenty four 4.3/4" squares

From fabric 3 for the backing cut two pieces 68" length of fabric 3 across the width of fabric. Remove selvedge edge, and sew together along the long edge of the fabric. Cut to make a piece 68" by 68". For the binding cut five 2.1/2" lengths of fabric 3 across the width of fabric.

From fabric 4 cut twenty six 4.3/4" squares, cut and piece 2.1/2" wide strips, two 56.1/2" long and two 60.1/2" long for the border

From fabric 5 cut forty eight 3.1/2" squares

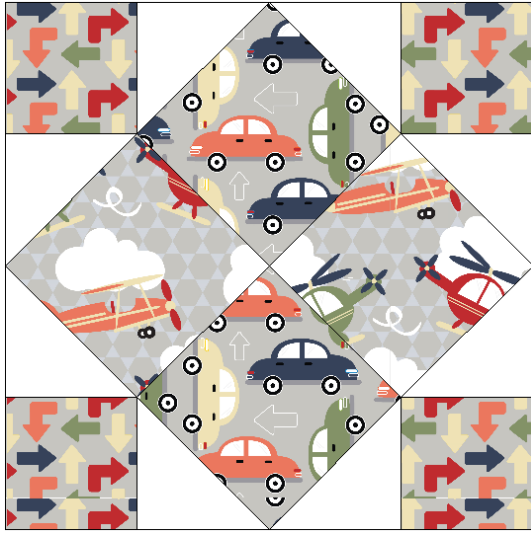
From fabric 6 cut twenty six 4.3/4" squares

From fabric 7 cut one hundred 3.7/8" squares

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.

Sewing

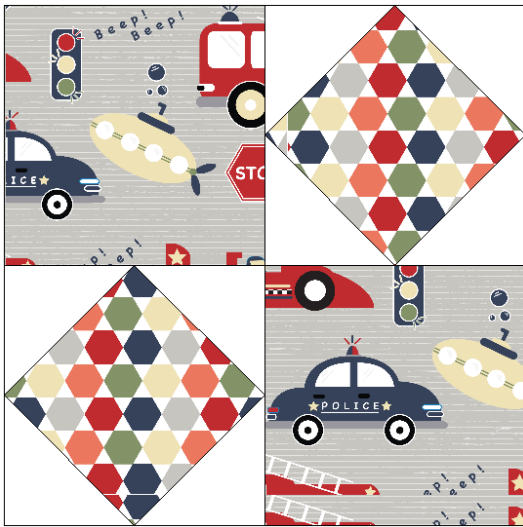
You will need to make two different quilt blocks.



Block 1

Sew the fabric 2 and fabric 4 squares together in pairs. Sew two pairs of squares together to make a four patch unit. Make twelve of these.

Cut the fabric 7 squares in half along one diagonal to make triangles. Sew two of these triangles to two adjacent sides of each fabric 5 square. Make sure that the white triangles are placed so that overall a large triangle is formed. Sew one of these large triangles to each edge of the four patch unit created from fabrics 2 and 4. Make twelve of block 1.



Block 2

Cut the fabric 7 squares in half along one diagonal to create triangles. Sew one triangle to each edge of a fabric 6 square. Make twenty six of these. Sew each one to a fabric 1 square. Sew two of these pairs of squares together to make a four patch unit. Take care to place them so that the fabric 1 squares are diagonally opposite each other. Make thirteen of block 2.

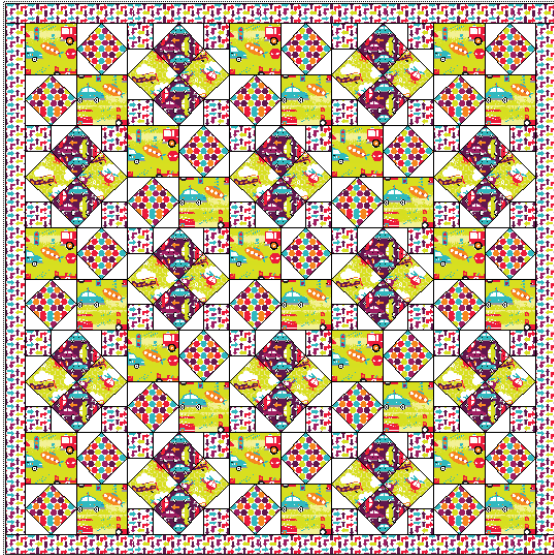
Assembling the Zoom Quilt

You will have 25 quilt blocks altogether. Lay them out in five rows of five. Begin row 1 with quilt block 1 and then alternate the blocks across the row. Begin row 2 with quilt block 2 and then alternate the blocks across the row. Continue to make the rows, alternating the first block of each row so that the blocks alternate across the rows and down the columns of the quilt. Sew them together in five rows of five.

For the border sew the two 56.1/2" lengths of fabric 4 to the sides of the quilt and sew the two 60.1/2" strips to the top and bottom.

For the backing fabric you will need 68" squares of both backing fabric 3 and wadding.

For the binding, sew the five strips of fabric 3 together to give one very long strip to make the binding.



Zoom Quilt 3

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Requirements

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| 5. Cars FF238 | ½ yard – 50cm |
| 6. Arrows FF241 | 1.3/8 yard - 1.25mtr |
| 7. White | 1.1/4yds - 1.15mtr |

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut twenty six 6.1/2" squares

From fabric 2 cut twenty four 4.3/4" squares

From fabric 3 for the backing cut two pieces 68" length of fabric 3 across the width of fabric. Remove selvedge edge, and sew together along the long edge of the fabric. Cut to make a piece 68" by 68". For the binding cut five 2.1/2" lengths of fabric 3 across the width of fabric.

From fabric 4 cut twenty six 4.3/4" squares, cut and piece 2.1/2" wide strips, two 56.1/2" long and two 60.1/2" long for the border

From fabric 5 cut forty eight 3.1/2" squares

From fabric 6 cut twenty six 4.3/4" squares

From fabric 7 cut one hundred 3.7/8" squares

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances.

Sewing

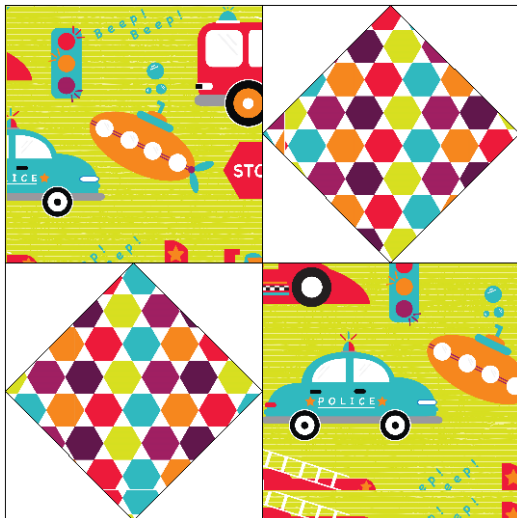
