Staffing update:

Head of Care Dan Healy has resigned to take up an inspectorial post with Ofsted (residential) at Easter 2019 - after 9 excellent years at Lakeside.

Internal acting up/cover arrangements have been made.

Vacancies for one/two LSAs and one residential child care worker.

New night wake-in staff member Karen has been appointed – Karen Scott.

Year 6 temporary Outreach Assessment class (max 5 pupils) starts Monday 18 March, funded by SEN with a primary specialist 'longer term' supply teacher.

Summary of actions taken this year:

- Attendance Awareness Week in September with packs to all tutor groups
- Successful Year 7 transition programme – positive impact with all Year 7s settling well. Average attendance for year 7s is 98%, with 15 achieving 100%

- All pupils reviewed each Half Term and letters sent
- 100% attenders rewarded with certificate in assembly and extra raffle tickets - displayed on attendance display board
- Certificates will be presented to all pupils who achieve 95% and above attendance, who are also rewarded with raffle tickets for a chance to win a JD Voucher or Tablet
- Certificates presented to pupils who have improved their attendance and letters sent home
- Well done letters sent to all Year 7 and new starter parent/carers at Half-Term
- Every pupil reviewed at end of half term and term with letters sent to all with unauthorised absences
- Team Around the Family meetings held, where appropriate, to support pupil's with low attendance
- 1 x pupil subject to court proceedings for poor attendance
- 1 x Penalty Notice sent
- 5 x Penalty Notice warning sent
