

Residential Report for Governors September 2018

It has been a positive start to the new academic year with pupils and staff seeming pleased to be back and engaging in the opportunities on offer.

We have had a new RCCW and member of night waking staff started. A second night care worker is due to start after half term. The new staff have settled in well and are working well through their induction.

Activities so far this term have included Moors Valley Country Park, swimming and on-site sports competitions.

We have two year 7's due to start boarding at the end of September with dates to be agreed for a further two year 7's. This is likely to start at the beginning of next half term.

Residential staff are involved with medication training on the inset day on Monday 17th Sept 2018. They will also be attending training on the Early Help Hub and Section 47 referrals.
