

REPORT OF GOVERNOR'S VISIT TO LAKESIDE SCHOOL

Purpose of visit: to meet to review the pupil premium (PP) strategy for 2018/19

Summary of experiences

- Each of the interventions was reviewed and the impact they are having was scrutinized.
- All strategies were having a positive impact on outcomes for the pupils.
- It was noted that with such a high number of pupils in receipt of PP often the interventions benefited all pupils the class. This was seen as a positive all the pupils have complex needs so the more support they receive can only be a good outcome.
- Attendance figures were very positive overall although they were issues in one year group, but all appropriate actions were being taken in respect of the pupils concerned.
- All staff receive relevant CPD to support the implementation of the plan and 2 are working towards advancement in their respective roles.
- The 'My Concerns' system was discussed and was seen to be an effective safeguarding tool.
- Issues around pupils receiving support being reintegrated into the school when the intervention was making a difference was discussed and it was noted this is now working more effectively.
