

Tawheed Al Uloohiyyah


Worship is for Allah alone.

Allah has the best names and attributes.



Maashaa Allah! You have just learn two attributes of Allah.



(2) Who is your Prophet?



Muhammad (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) is our Prophet. Allah sent him to all the people.

When you say prophet Muhammad you should always say sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam.

Prophet Muhammad lived a long time ago.

Full Name

His full name was Muhammad ibn Abdullah ibn Abdul Mutallib ibn Haashim; He was from the Quraysh (Arabs).

Date of Birth

He was born on a Monday in the Islamic month of Rabee Al Awwal in Mecca.

<u>Mother</u>

Prophet Muhammad's (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) mother was called Aamina.

<u>Father</u>

Prophet Muhammad's father was called Abdullah.

Growing up

Muhammad (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) grew up as an orphan, he was raised by he's grandfather and then he's uncle Abu Taalib who took very good care of him. Prophet Muhammad (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) was breastfed by a woman called Halima.

When Prophet Muhammad (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) was young, he worked as a shepherd just like the other Prophets. He also used to work in trade (buying and selling) with his uncle Abu Taalib.

The Qur'an and Prophet Muhammad

Allah sent the Qur'an to Prophet Muhammad to teach us Tawheed. Angel Jibril brought down the Quran to Prophet Muhammad at the cave of Hiraa near Mecca. He became a prophet when he was 40 years old.

he loved Allah's Book. He was very kind and full of mercy even when others were cruel to him. He was the best person ever! We should all try and be like him.


We do not pray to him




(3) What is your Religion? مَا دِينُكَ؟ دِينِي إِسْلاَمٌ


