Rules and Expectations

During these visits, we have a high set of standards for both players and parents to uphold. Please come prepared for the following:

Players:

- All players must wear a Bay to Bay shirt or sweatshirt during the visits
- All players should come prepared with 3-4 specific questions PER SCHOOL. There will be a Q&A session at each institution, and all players will be expected to participate. For example: *“What is the biggest difference you see in your Freshman athletes versus your Senior athletes?”* (Don’t be afraid to get specific).
- Players are not allowed to be on their phones while a college coach is speaking. There will be times to take photos, but please remain courteous while any coach is addressing the group (same goes for parents).

Parents:

- First and foremost, these visits are for the players and need to be player driven. DO NOT “hijack” a visit by taking on the role of the question asker. Each college coach will provide opportunities for parents to ask questions, please wait until this opportunity is presented by a coach.
- As parents and coaches, we will be taking a hands off approach during the visits. Meaning that the players are going to have to take charge and do the bulk of the communication. Please help us encourage the players in “taking the lead”.
