Evaluation & Selection Process

The 2018 BCSPL intake is for boys and girls born in 2006. Younger players (2007) can be evaluated and considered. BC Soccer governs the evaluation window and the process for offering spots and officially signing players to the team.

Key Evaluation Windows

February 2 nd - March 4 th 2018	Invitations to join an EA Sports BC Soccer Premier League club may be offered to a player who resides inside that member club and partner clubs (regional based) at any time within the evaluation window
February 18 th 2018 - 6PM Onward	The next phase of invitations to join an EA Sports BC Soccer Premier League club may be offered to players who <u>DO NOT</u> reside inside that member club and partner clubs (regional based)
March 4 th 2018 - 6PM Onward	The final phase of invitations to join an EA Sports BC Soccer Premier League club may be offered to all players within the evaluation process at the completion of the evaluation window

Registration and Evaluation Location

Players are required to pre-register for evaluations at coastafc.ca. The cost to participate in the evaluation process is \$20 and is payable at the time of registration.

Evaluations will take place on South Surrey Athletic Park's Turf Fields #3 and #9, which are located at 2199 148th St.
