SYNOPSIS OF UPCOMING FILMS

APOLLO 11 (2019-G) 1 hr. 33 min. Documentary/History. “*The NASA mission at the heart of the must-see documentary Apollo 11 reminds you what it feels to be truly awestruck.*” Apollo 11 is a cinematic space event film fifty years in the making. Featuring never-before-seen large-format film footage of one of humanity's greatest accomplishments.

GLORIA BELL (2019-R) 1hr. 42 min. Comedy/Drama/Romance. “*A movie that says the stories of average women deserve to be told, as do the stories of people who grapple with big challenges but still face each day with hope and wonder.*”

Gloria (Julianne Moore) is a free-spirited divorcée who spends her days at a straight-laced office job and her nights on the dance floor, joyfully letting loose at clubs around Los Angeles. After meeting Arnold (John Turturro) on a night out, she finds herself thrust into an unexpected new romance, filled with both the joys of budding love and the complications of dating, identity and family.

HOW TO TRAIN YOUR DRAGON: THE HIDDEN WORLD (2019-PG) 1hr. 44 min. Animation/Action/Adventure. “*A perfect finale for a timeless trilogy.*” Now chief and ruler of Berk alongside Astrid, Hiccup has created a gloriously chaotic dragon utopia. When the sudden appearance of female Light Fury coincides with the darkest threat their village has ever faced, Hiccup and Toothless must leave the only home they've known and journey to a hidden world thought only to exist in myth. As their true destinies are revealed, dragon and rider will fight together-to the very ends of the Earth-to protect everything they've grown to treasure.

STYX (2019-NR) 1hr. 34min. Drama. “*A taut moral thriller, "Styx" is a story of what happens when self-reliance runs into other people's desperation.*” Rike--40, a doctor from Europe--embodies a typical Western model of happiness and success. She is educated, confident, determined and committed. We see Rike's everyday life, as an emergency doctor, before she fulfills a long-held dream and sails out to sea alone in her sailing boat. Her goal: Ascension Island in the Atlantic Ocean. But her dream holiday is quickly broken off on the high seas, when, after a storm, she finds herself near a stricken fishing boat. Around a hundred people are about to drown. Rike follows maritime law and radios for help. As her request is going nowhere, she is forced to make a momentous decision.

THE LEGO MOVIE 2: THE SECOND PART (2019-PG) 1 hrs. 47 min. Animation/Action/Adventure. “*A hugely ambitious sequel, joyous and genuinely complex, that's charged with dramatic and musical energy to the very last frame.*” The much-anticipated sequel to the critically acclaimed, global box office phenomenon that started it all, “The LEGO (R) Movie 2: The Second Part,” reunites the heroes of Bricksburg in an all new action-packed adventure to save their beloved city.
