Where in the World Did Our Shoeboxes Go?

Thanks to you for partnering with Operation Christmas Child and for donating online to discover the destination of your shoebox gift. The gift-filled shoeboxes you packed will share God's love in a tangible way and can impact not only the child who receives it, but also their family, friends, and community. Shiloh shoeboxes were sent to destinations in Mexico, Mali, and hard to reach areas.

- Mexico has 123.1 million people and is located in North America
- 28% of the population in Mexico is 14 years old or younger
- Mali has 16.9 million people and is located in West Africa
- 47% of the population in Mali is 14 years old or younger

Many children who live in nations that are difficult to reach with the Gospel are able to hear about Jesus Christ through specially packed shoebox gifts designated for hard-to-reach areas. In restricted areas, these shoeboxes provide a platform for local believers to share Christ in a safe and culturally sensitive way, and allow ease of entry through customs.

Shoebox gifts collected in the United States in 2016 will be delivered to **1,178,246** children living in hard-to-reach areas in 21 countries. For the safety of our ministry partners living in these restricted areas, we cannot divulge the names of the countries. Most importantly, please remember to pray for the child and their family who receives your gift.

Start looking for items for packing 2017 shoeboxes. The donation box for Operation Christmas Child shoebox items is located in the Fellowship Hall. Suggested items of the month are listed in the newsletter but any items you find during the year as you shop are welcome. Check the OCC brochure for items that are not accepted.
