However, we need to increase our income to do this work and we rely 100% on donations and sponsorship.

It's a full day event and should be amazing fun as well as being a challenge for those who fear heights. We will abseil, down rocks up to 100 foot tall.

The cost is £59 - £65 per person depending on numbers and we will provide sponsor forms.
