

BRANCH SCHOLARSHIP REQUEST

The San Francisco Branch has scholarship funds available to dancers and musicians that are to be used to further the interests of Scottish Country Dancing. The maximum grant is \$300.00 and, **to be eligible, applicants must be current members of the San Francisco Branch.**

The grant is intended to help members with financial need cover some of the expense of a training program, e.g., workshops, etc. Applicants may be awarded only one grant per event and recipients may be asked to help out with operational functions at that event. All requests and awards will be kept confidential. Assistance will be granted without discrimination on the basis of race, age, religion, sex, color, nationality, ancestry or place of origin.
