Hurricane Delta Debris Pickup Progress
From Mayor Barrow

11-2-20 update:

Tree debris removal from Hurricane Delta continues in Central. Crews have finished pickup in subdivisions in the western and middle parts of the city including Winchester, Monhegan, Tanglewood, Carmel Acres, Comite Hills West, Comite Hills, Hampton Village, Lovett Rd, Morgan Place, Morgan Place West, Boganvilla, Lazy Lakes, Gurney Rd, Willowood Acres, Jackson Park, Jackson Place, Core Ln, Northeast Place, Arbor Grove, Huntington Park, Rambling Oaks, Country Estates, Beau Bois, Carey Rd, Brown Rd, the front part of Northwoods, and they will move to other areas of the city afterwards.

So far, over 165 truck loads of tree debris have been delivered to the dump site with over 7,500 cubic yards collected so far.

Crews are only picking up tree debris from Hurricane Delta. Wooden fence material will be picked up by Republic Waste as part of regular trash collection. Any piles with mixed tree debris and trash will not be picked up. You must have your tree debris from Hurricane Delta in a separate pile. Crews are passing down each street only once.

DOTD is responsible for pickup along state highways, and the Parish contractor is responsible for pickup along Sullivan Rd, Joor Rd north of Hooper, Comite Dr, and Dyer Rd.

Please do not stack debris next to mailboxes, gas meters, or on top of water meters, under utility lines, or in the roadway.

We ask for everyone's patience as the cleanup continues.
