Re: Summary of June 2020

During the month of June 2020, here are some of the activities that took place with your local government:

- City Council on June 9 approved the 2020-21 General Fund Operating Budget effective July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021.
- City Council approved Mallory Scott Mills as a part-time dispatcher with the Central Police Department.
- Mayor Barrow executed an agreement with ChemPro Services, Inc. for herbicide application/weed spraying in ditches and canals within the city.
- City Council approved rezonings for a trucking company at 9783 Hooper Rd and for a daycare center at 9886 Hooper Rd. The trucking company will tear down the old “Our Place” restaurant and construct a new building. The daycare center will use an existing, unoccupied building.
- City Council approved the first residential neighborhood since taking office. The 35-lot Legacy Oaks subdivision will be located south of Arbor Grove subdivision on Joor Rd north of Sullivan Rd. The subdivision met all criteria of the Master Plan and Zoning Code with no waivers.
- The final plat for the Settlement at Shoe Creek was signed on June 25. The developers will soon start home construction.
- The Chamber of Commerce launched the #HelloLocalCentral shopping campaign.
- Frenchtown Rd, Willowbrook Ave, and Huntley Ave were all overlaid as part of the Asphalt Street Rehabilitation Program. The roundabout on Lovett Rd received some modifications as well.
