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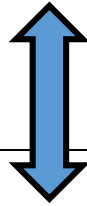

Elementary Level Art Educator of the Year	To recognize an elementary school art teacher member for extraordinary achievements and service of school, district, regional, state, and/or national significance during previous years.	-Elementary School Art Teacher (public, private, or homeschool) -current KyAEA and NAEA member
Middle Level Art Educator of the Year	To recognize a middle school art teacher for extraordinary achievements and service of school, district, regional, state, and/or national significance during previous years.	-Middle School Art Teacher (public, private, or homeschool) -current KyAEA and NAEA member
Secondary Level Educator of the Year	To recognize a high school art teacher for extraordinary achievements and service of school, district, regional, state, and/or national significance during previous years.	-High School Art Teacher (public, private, or homeschool) -current KyAEA and NAEA member
Higher Education Art Educator of the Year	To recognize a collegiate art educator for extraordinary achievements and service of post-secondary, regional, state, and/or national significance during previous years.	-College instructor, professor or adjunct (public or private) -current KyAEA and NAEA member
Special Needs Champion Art Educator of the Year	To recognize an art teacher who has made distinguished professional contributions to art education for students with special needs through scholarly writing, research, professional leadership, teaching, and/or community service during previous years.	- Art Teacher at any level (public, private, or homeschool) -current KyAEA and NAEA member

Step 1: Purchase a hot Starbucks beverage in the Student Center.

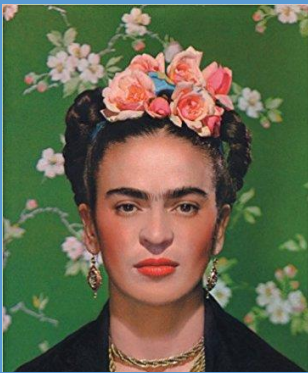
Step 2: After rinsing out your cup, turn it into a canvas and decorate it!

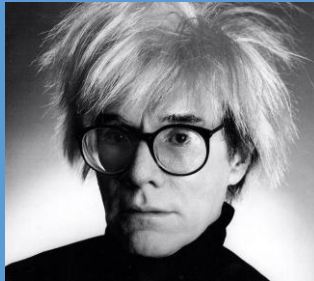

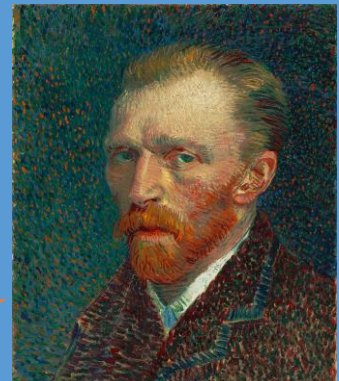
