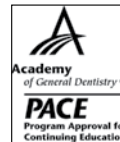

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Seventy percent of children by age 12 have a malocclusion. Parents are looking for dentists who offer early treatment for their children. Ideally, treatment with functional appliances will prevent the need for extraction of permanent teeth.

The most common malocclusion is Class II malocclusion with underdeveloped lower jaws. Functional appliances such as a Twin Block or MARA appliance can be used to move the lower jaw forward in 7 months. This avoids the need for extractions or jaw surgery at a later date.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

1. Diagnose simple orthodontic cases that can be treated with functional appliances in mixed dentition.
2. Functional appliances to treat constricted arches, posterior crossbites, anterior crossbites, deep overbites, open bites due to tongue thrust or thumbsucking habits.
3. How to adjust functional appliances.
4. Technique for bite registration with Twin Block and MARA appliance.
5. How early orthodontic treatment can increase your personal satisfaction and income for your practice.
