Re: Proposed Amendments

Please find enclosed the proposed amendments that have been submitted by the deadline of February 1, 2019.

A number of the submissions made by the NOHA Board of Directors are housekeeping in nature. Below are the motion numbers that we feel are housekeeping:

With your support, we would ask that the membership approve these motions in a block. If there are any concerns with any of the motions being dealt with in the block, we can deal with them individually.

Regulation 6

You will notice in your package of proposed amendments that there is a proposal to amend Regulation 6, with the purpose of creating freedom of movement for Representative Hockey.

In this submission, it is proposed that R.6.1.b) and R.6.2.1.b) be removed. If approved by the membership, these changes will mean that all players – regardless of whether they are Representative or House League – will have freedom of movement.

More importantly, there are a number of other Regulations in Regulation #6 which would need to be amended in order to achieve the intended result; as it stands, there are Regulations that are

contradictory to the intended result given that the Regulation applies to all hockey programming within the NOHA, not just Representative hockey.

Officiating Rates

Motions #19 and #20 in the enclosed package deal with Officiating rates. They have been submitted separately as the first motion, #19, deals with AAA Leagues only. The AAA Leagues have supported these rates going forward. In this motion, we did not address any of the wording below the fees chart.

The second motion, #20, deals with all other rates and propose that the fees be based on the time commitment (game length) of the Official as opposed to the calibre of the league/game. This motion also proposes that the game fees be the same, whether it is a regular season/exhibition game or a playoff game. Finally, it seeks to provide clarification as to the fees paid in the two official system.
