Re: HTCP Level III Trainers – Full Course – North Bay – April 25, 2020

The Northern Ontario Hockey Association is pleased to announce that a Hockey Trainers Certification Program (HTCP) Level III Full Course has been scheduled to take place on Saturday, April 25, 2020 in North Bay.

The HTCP Level III Clinic is an advanced program, providing the participant the opportunity to enhance their skill and knowledge level through group discussions and hands-on experience. The HTCP Level III Trainers Certification is not a requirement at any level within the NOHA, it is strongly recommended for those trainers that want to work or are working with Bantam AAA, Midget AAA, and Junior-A teams.

Topics to be covered include:

- Practical Nutrition
- Shoulder and Knee Injuries
- Head/Neck/Spinal Injuries
- Severe Lacerations
- Introduction to Athletic Taping
- Practical Taping Session

Upon completion of the clinic, participants will be required to write the HTCP Level III Exam on their own and must achieve a passing grade of 75% to receive their certification. HTCP Level III certification expires every three years with an expiration date of August/Year.

Eligibility

Participants must hold a current valid Level II Trainers card to attend. Current Level I Trainers who are interested in attending can provide proof of Standard First Aid (or other equivalent qualifications) plus a fee of \$5.65 to be upgraded to Level II and be eligible to attend the Level III Clinic.

Participant Fee

The cost to attend the HTCP Level III Clinic for Trainers that were registered to NOHA teams is \$132.74 + HST (\$150.00). The fee includes lunch and dinner, as well as the HTCP Level III

Manual, Nancy Clark Nutrition Book and Athletic Taping/Bracing Book. This cost has been reduced significantly through a subsidy received by the NOHA Board of Directors.

The HTCP Level III Clinic is not restricted to NOHA Members only, however, the cost to attend for Trainers registered on teams outside of the NOHA is \$265.49 + HST (\$300.00).

Agenda and Location

The course length is 9 hours (approximately 12 hours in total when factoring meals and breaks), and is scheduled to begin at 9:00 AM and end at 8:45 PM. The location of the clinic is the Best Western Hotel and Conference Centre in North Bay.

Accommodations

The NOHA will be providing a block of rooms at the Best Western Hotel and Conference Centre for participants that are attending the HTCP Level III Trainers Clinic. More information on these rooms will be provided to those that register for the clinic.

Throughout his tenure with Hockey Eastern Ontario (previously Ottawa District Hockey Association), he has been involved in all aspects of training from house league to the National Hockey League. Hockey Canada has called upon him to assist in various symposiums across the country. Chuck's dedication to the sport, the training program, and Risk and Safety Education continues to have a positive influence on all trainers/safety individuals in the HEO branch. Chuck has delivered the last five HTCP Level III Trainer Clinics in the NOHA.
