Re: Grassroots Festival Proposal – 2019-20 Season

Over the last several seasons, the Northern Ontario Hockey Association has hosted a series of Grassroots Festivals in communities across the North. The NOHA is currently looking for Minor Hockey Associations that are interested in hosting a Grassroots Festival in the 2019-20 season.

What is a Grassroots Festival?

NOHA Grassroots Festivals are structured as a one-day event aimed at Initiation and Novice-aged players (Atom and Pee wee players can be included in the day if need be). Players attend two on-ice sessions taught by an NOHA Trained Instructor that emphasize the principles of the Initiation/Novice Programs, including fun, team work, and skill development. Players also attend either one or two off-ice sessions consisting of fun games, stretching, or off-ice stickhandling. Participating players will receive a gift from the NOHA and be provided with lunch.

As part of the NOHA Grassroots Festival, your Minor Hockey Association's coaches will be able to attend a Free Hockey Canada Instructional Stream Clinic, led by an NOHA Learning Facilitator. Lastly, your area's officials will be able to attend a development seminar to improve their skills.

Minor Hockey Association Responsibilities

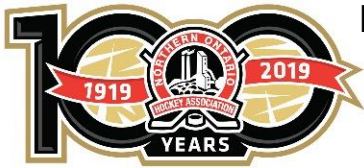
The event would be at no-cost to your Association but we would require your assistance in providing ice time, volunteers, and a hall for off-ice activities. I have included an outline of the ideal amount of volunteers required to run a Grassroots Festival (please note that this is an ideal scenario, Grassroots Festivals can be run with less volunteers than what is outlined in this document). In addition, I have included an agenda from one of this season's events to help you understand the ice time requirements. Please note that the agenda can be adjusted based on the Association's ice or hall/boardroom availability.

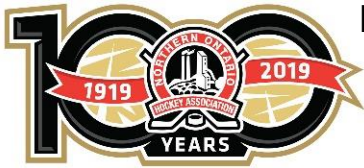

Ideal Number of Volunteers Required

Players Program: 10 volunteers total

- Five coaches for each on-ice session.
- Two volunteers to help with registration and handout lunch.
- Three coaches or volunteers to run/assist with off-ice games.

Coaches Program: 1 volunteer total

- One volunteer to help with classroom setup and registration

Officials Program: 1 volunteers total

- One volunteer to help with classroom setup and registration

**Please note that these are ideal circumstances. Grassroots Festival can be run with a minimum of 7 volunteers.*
