

The Final Judgment from the Worldly Perspective

“Go pour out the 7 bowls of the wrath of God.”

1. Loathsome, Malignant Sores

Judgment of God - Exodus - Boils (9:8-12)

Philistines - Ark of the Covenant

* An Outward Expression of an Inward Problem *

Separation of God's People from the World

→ [Only on those who received the mark of the beast]

2. Sea Turned Into Blood - Every living thing in the sea died.

→ 2nd Trumpet - 1/3 of sea, 1/3 of creatures died (Rev. 8:8-9)

Egypt - Nile River Turned Into Blood! (Exodus 7:14-23)

3. Rivers and Springs of Water Become Blood

→ 3rd Trumpet - 1/3 of Rivers, Many Men Died ((Rev 8:10-11)

(Exodus 7:24-25)

*Pronouncement of Righteous Judgment

Righteous - Holy → Judged

Blood to Drink → Poured out the blood of the saints

→ (Rev 6:10) Martyrs - From the Altar - Amen! True are Your judgments!

4. The Sun and Its Scorching Power - Ozone

Versus 4th Trumpet - 1/3 of sun and moon - Less light

* Response of the Earth Dwellers - Did not repent! → (So as to give God glory.)

5. Darkness over the Kingdom of the Beast

→ Exodus Plague - Darkness over the Egyptians (Exodus 10:21f)

→ The suffering of pain seems greater in the darkness.

→ Still they did not repent!

6. Dried Up the Euphrates River - To Prepare the Way for the Kings of the East to Join the Battle of Armageddon!

→ 6th Trumpet - Release of the Angels of the Euphrates and the 200 million men army!

How? Unclean Spirits - Demons who will deceive the king of the earth!

“Go pour out the 7 bowls of the wrath of God.”

7. A Great Earthquake - Never Before Like It! Great City Split Into 3 Parts

Wrath of God Upon Babylon!

→ Every island fled away and the mountains were not found!

*Huge hailstones came down from heaven upon men. → Egyptian plague (Exodus 9:18-26)

→ Men blasphemed God because of the plagues!

Two Phrases to Remember:

(a) “It is done.” - The Final, Ultimate Judgment and Cleansing of the Earth from Its Entrapment in Sin.

→ It is finished. Jesus finished the judgment upon men’s sins. Judgment upon the world is complete.

(b) “Behold I am coming like a thief.”

→ Stay awake.

→ Keep your garment.
