Welcome to April, and a day closer to being together as a school community as our world journeys through the coronavirus pandemic. I cannot wait to see all of you and actually shake your hand, look you in the eye, and greet you with a heartfelt message of, "WELCOME BACK!" I know we still have a distance to go before this becomes a reality but each day, we get closer. Each day, I hold all of you in prayer and feel that God is definitely listening. During Mass this past Sunday, I focused on the need for PEACE in our world. Peace calms fears and clears minds. At the end of Mass at St. Luke, Fr. Brad asked all of us to participate in a guided meditation. He asked everyone to close their eyes and invite the Lord to be with them, and then hold their hands out, palms up. He then instructed all to ask the Lord what it is we want help with. Take a moment with that. Then, ask the Lord what He wants to give you instead. A friend shared this with me, and the result was powerful. If you haven't done this, I encourage you to do so today.

Thank you also for participating in conferences remotely last week. Teachers and staff reported how encouraged they are by the progress your children are making during this time of distance learning. Several suggestions were shared on how we can streamline weekly schedules and communications. We are taking all of these into consideration as we move to a common place on our website where families can more easily access their child's weekly schedule. It is our goal to get this in place by the end of this week. Additionally, you will see the St. Luke Distance Learning Plan that has been developed. Please take time to read through it as a guide to support healthy habits while your child participates in remote learning. We also will be providing resources throughout this time to help all of us maintain mental wellness.

Lastly, the IB attribute for April is REFLECTIVE – *"We thoughtfully consider the world and our own ideas and experience. We work to understand our strengths and weaknesses in order to support our learning and personal development."* I love this attribute and this quote by Margaret J. Wheatley – "Without reflection, we go blindly on our way, creating more unintended consequences, and failing to achieve anything useful." May you take time during these last weeks of Lent to be intentional on personal reflection as you observe new life that this season brings, and new joy that comes with Easter.

We will get through this! Take time to do Fr. Brad's meditation exercise. Reflect on what God is asking you to do. Be strong, look for the beauty around you, listen to the birds sing, smell the flowers, and know YOU are making a huge difference by your "call to action". During this uncertain time, look for peaceful moments of reflection and listen to the call of the Holy Spirit to be an *inquiring mind, heart for Jesus, and "clean" hands for service.*

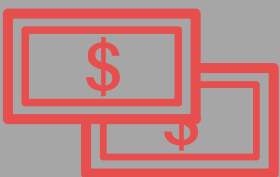

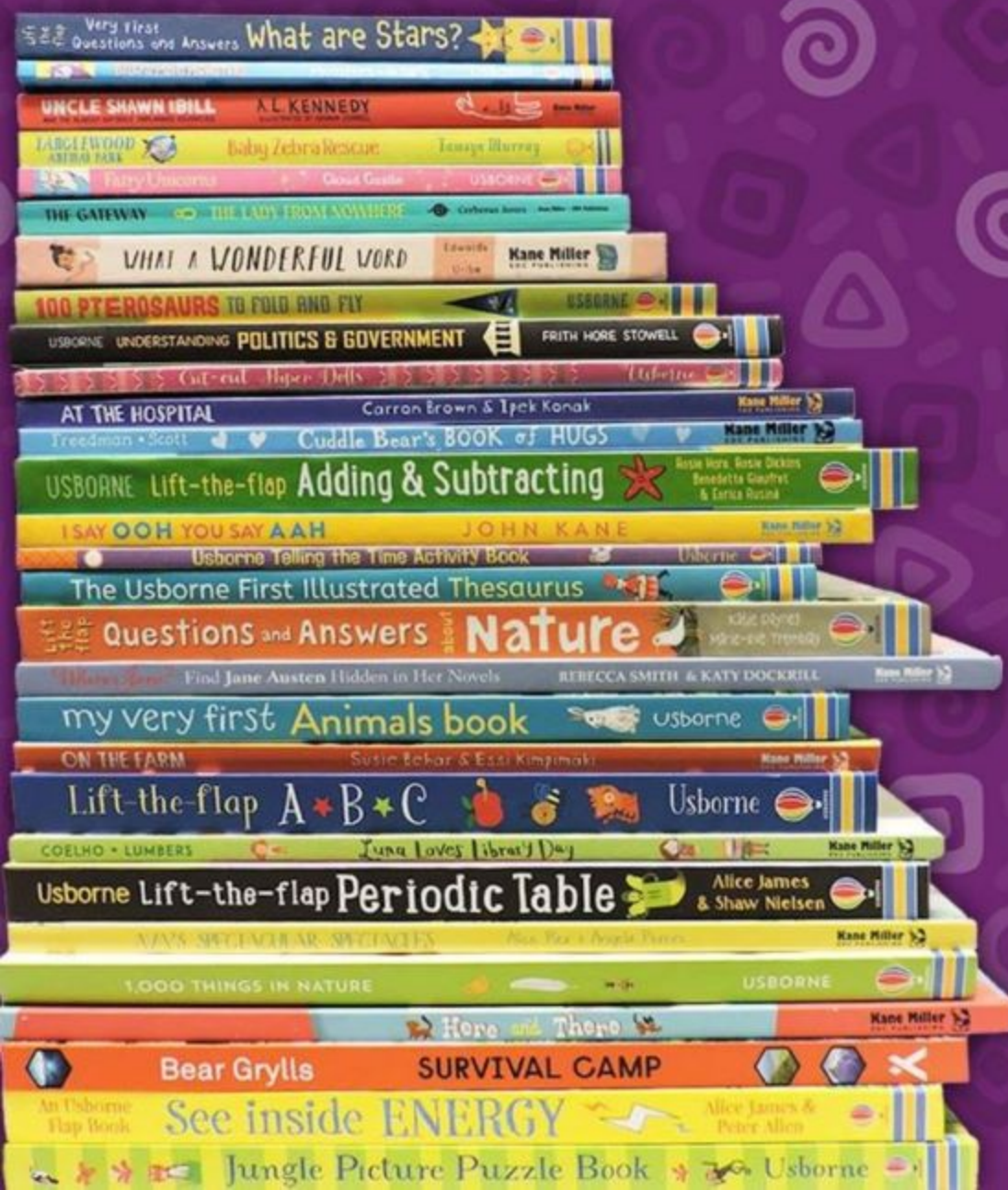
