SHILTON PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S REPORT from Mr Malcom Linney Wednesday 9 July 2014

The aims of Shilton Parish Council are to:

- Provide effective communication
- Encourage a sounding board for local public opinion
- Provide and improve local and County provided services/amenities
- Establish a strong contact with planning
- Work with other local Parish Councils
- Liaise with suppliers, operating services within the Parish

Our current focus is to:

1. Update our Parish website and use it as our main method of communication.
2. Revise the parish agenda so that public opinion is heard first. Actions resulting from the public section of the agenda should be communicated and updated through the web site.
3. Encourage each councilor to drive, coordinate and communicate on a specific aim.
4. Support the various committees within the Parish.
5. Complete the attenuation dams.
6. Form a group to look into the issues of sewerage in the Parish.
7. Form a group to support the actions required to challenge large housing development proposals.
8. Review our banking signatories and period reporting of balance sheet.
9. Conclude the weight restriction programme in Shilton village.

Since my election on 28 May, I have attended four meetings

1. An extraordinary Parish meeting to decide upon the 2015/16 Parish precept increase of £20 per household.
2. The Bradwell Management Services meeting to introduce myself to residents and explain our approach to the flooding and sewerage issues.
3. A meeting of councilors and Mr. and Mrs. Garbutt reference the West Carterton housing development plan and the actions required to challenge it effectively.
4. A CPRE chaired meeting in Filkins village hall to discuss the implications of the West Carterton housing proposal.

I have also met with the Mayor and Town Clerk of Carterton Town Council to commence a working together relationship. I will meet with other Parish chairpersons in due course.

You will note that any outstanding actions will be published for each Parish Council meeting.
