

SHOT CLOCKS

FINA comments:

The intent is that in most situations, from a **second** possession in the **same** sequence, a team will have a maximum of 20 seconds possession time left.

30 seconds

- **The timekeeper recording the possession time shall set the clock to 30 seconds:**
 - at the start of each quarter
 - after a goal is scored
 - after a change of possession, and
 - after an attack ball under

20 seconds

- **The timekeeper recording the possession time shall set the clock to 20 seconds:**
 - when the ball is put into play after awarding a corner (2m) throw
 - after a rebound from a shot which does not cause change of possession, and
 - after a defence ball under

20 seconds or the greater time if the shot clock is greater than 20 seconds

- **The timekeeper recording the possession time shall set the clock to 20 seconds or leave it at the greater time after:**
 - an exclusion or penalty
 - If more than 20 seconds is on the shot clock at the time of the exclusion or penalty, that greater time will remain.
