Local Attractions

The city of Delta is located on the western slope of Colorado and is approximately 40 miles south of Grand Junction off of I-70. The city is surrounded by multiple attractions including the Grand Mesa National Forest, Gunnison Gorge National Conservation Area, and the Dominguez-Escalante National Conservation Area.

Not only does Delta sit in the middle of these three amazing natural treasures, the Uncompahgre River and the Gunnison River meet at the city's Confluence Park. The Gunnison River is well known for its Gold Medal waters and the Grand Mesa has over 300 lakes.

Delta is also known as a golfing destination. We celebrate Devil's Thumb Golf Course which has been recognized as a top course in the state. We also have one of the finest disc golf courses in the region. Gunnison's Edge Disc Golf Course located at Confluence Park has a perfect blend of challenges that will make for a great day of golf.


