NOTEWORTHY

- Freshman Garret Kingsbury recorded his first career win with 20 saves on 23 shots. Alabama outshot Midland, 39-23
- Junior Taylor Joseph and senior Jeremy Hannah each recorded three points. That marks both players' season-high and Hannah's first multi-point game of the year.
- Senior Jack Rooney recorded his fifth career game-winning goal.
- Alabama improves to 10-5 on the season, with all 10 wins coming against Division-I opponents. The team has now surpassed last year's program-best mark of nine such victories. The game was also the first ever meeting of two ranked teams in Pelham.
