Presbyterian leaders approve gay clergy policy

Leaders of the Presbyterian Church (USA), which has more than 2 million members, voted Thursday to allow non-celibate gays in committed relationships to serve as clergy, approving the first of two policy changes that could make their church on of the most gay-friendly major Christian denominations in the United States. Delegates voted during the church's general assembly in Minneapolis, with 53 percent approving the more liberal policy on gay clergy. A separate vote is expected on whether to change the church's definition of marriage from between "a man and a woman" to between "two people." The changes will then need to be approved by a majority of the church's 173 U.S. presbyteries. Last year, 94 of the presbyteries voted against a change in the policy.

Under current church policy, Presbyterians are eligible to become clergy, deacons or elders only if they are married or celibate. The new policy would strike references to sexuality altogether in favor of candidates committed to "joyful submission to worship of Christ."

¹⁰ Now **I beseech you**, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all **speak the same thing**, and that there be **no divisions among you**; but that ye **be perfectly joined together** in the **same mind** and in the **same judgment**.

1 Corinthians 3

²I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able.

³ For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?

- ¹Behold, **the LORD's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save**; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear:
- ²But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.
- ³ For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with iniquity; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue hath muttered perverseness.
- ⁴ None calleth for justice, nor any pleadeth for truth: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity.

Titus 3

- ⁹ But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.
- ¹⁰ A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject:

Romans 16

- ¹⁷ Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them.
- ¹⁸ For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches **deceive the hearts of the simple**.

Separate or be separated...

Luke 6

²²Blessed are ye, when men shall hate you, and when they shall separate you from their company, and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of man's sake.

²³ Rejoice ye in that day, and leap for joy: for, behold, your reward is great in heaven: for in the like manner did their fathers unto the prophets.

2 Corinthians 6

¹⁷ Wherefore **come out from among them**, and **be ye separate**, saith the Lord, and **touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.**

¹¹ Knowing that he that is such is subverted, and sinneth, being condemned of himself.

Failure to Maintain Doctrine (Heresy) (cont))

1 Corinthians 11 (cont)

¹⁹ For there must be also **heresies among you**, that they which are **approved may be made manifest** among you.

2 Peter 2

- ¹But there were **false prophets also among the people**, even as **there shall be false teachers among you**, who privily shall **bring in damnable heresies**, even **denying the Lord** that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.
- ² And many shall follow their <u>pernicious</u> ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of.

Pernicious ways – NT:766 ἀσέλγεια **aselgeia** (as-elg'-i-a); from a compound of NT:1 (as a negative particle) and a presumed **selges** (of uncertain derivation, but apparently meaning continent); licentiousness (sometimes including other vices): KJV - filthy, lasciviousness, wantonness.

- ³ And through **covetousness** shall they with **feigned words** make merchandise of you: whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not.
- ⁴For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;
- ⁵ And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;
- ⁶ And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrha into ashes condemned them with an overthrow, making them an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly;
- ⁷ And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked:
- ⁸ (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds;)
- ⁹ The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the Day of Judgment to be punished:

Acts 24 The heretics will call us heretics...

- ¹³ Neither can they prove the things whereof they now accuse me.
- ¹⁴ But this I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets:
- ¹⁵ And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.
- ~So we Follow Christ, the head of the Church and body of Christ
- ~Keeping the Ordinances and remaining in order and in submission to God
- ~Putting on the One mind of Christ and agreeing together in the truth of His Word
- $\sim\!\!$ Maintaining the unity of the saints in this natural world according to spiritual enlightenment
- ~Thereby, we avoid confusion by edifying one another according to all the Holy Scriptures as we are taught by the Holy Spirit...
- ~Thus we avoid Divisions and there is no heresy among the saints...
- ~...and though the world judges the way we think to be heresy, so we shall worship God holding fast the things they consider heresy: we shall believe in the words written in the law and the prophets!
